DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: Rear Addition. New rear facing gable will tie onto existing cross gable below the ridge. Shed dormers will tie to both sides of new rear facing gable. A dormer will be also added on right side above last pair of windows of existing main floor. A window will be added onto side of shed on one side over the screened porch, and a matching window and a door with a small balcony will be added onto the other side (facing in to back yard). Materials (including siding, roofing, windows, trim, etc.) and details (including soffit/fascia treatment, overhang, brackets, trim, window configuration, etc.) will match existing. APPROVAL OF ANY SUBSTITUTE MATERIAL IS NOT IMPLIED. "

- > This Certificate of Appropriateness indicates that this project proposal has been determined to comply with the standards and policies of the Charlotte Historic District Commission.
- No other approvals are to be inferred.
- No demolition other than that specifically indicated on any attached plans is authorized under this approval.
- All work must be completed in accordance with all other applicable state and local codes.
- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.

This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.
