

DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: The project includes the installation of two temporary mobile classroom units to Dilworth Elementary School, see exhibits labeled 'Site Plan – June 2015' and 'Site Plan Detail – June 2015'. The mobile units have a footprint of 32' x 24' and will be 11' in height. The new mobile units will be located in an existing alcove currently being used as a dumpster area. An 8' wide wooden deck will connect the units and metal handrails, 5' wide ramps and stairs will be constructed to provide accessibility.

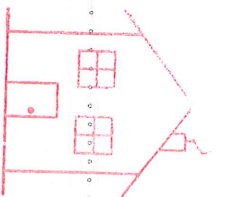
- This Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) indicates that this project proposal has been determined to comply with the standards and policies of the Charlotte Historic District Commission.

This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.

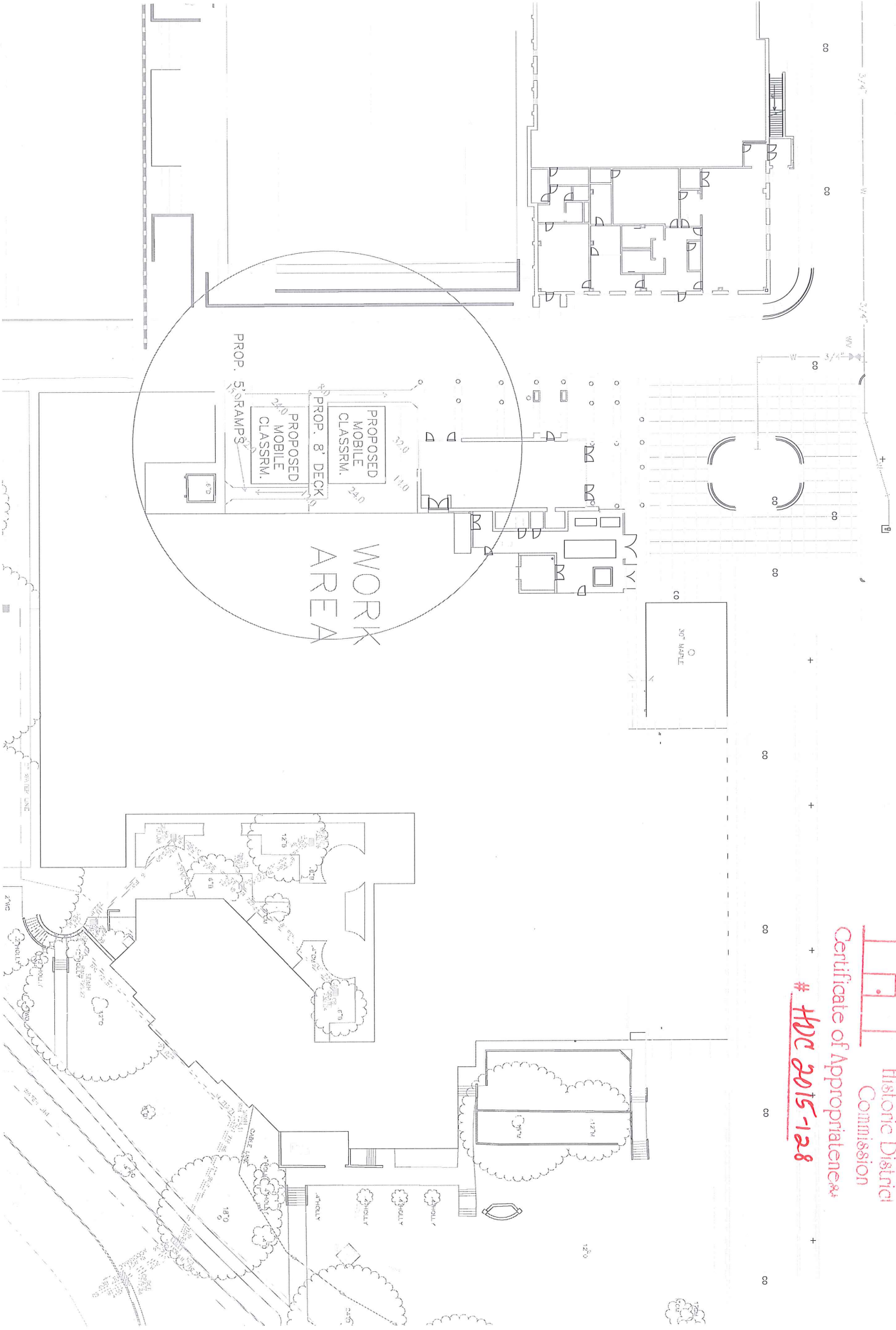
Side Plan Detail - June 2015
