DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: The project is a rear addition and replacement doors. The rear addition includes a one story addition with a grade to ridge height of 18'-5 1/8", which will tie into the existing roof below the ridge. The footprint measures 20'-4" x 24'-3 ¾". The exterior material will be wood lap siding with a 4½-inch reveal. The windows will be wood or vinyl clad with ½" or ¾" Simulated True Divided Light (STDL) exterior molded muntins, in a 4/1 pattern to match existing. All details (trim, eaves, cornerboards, etc.) will be wood. An existing chimney on the rear not visible from the street will be removed. Other improvements include new craftsman style front and side entry doors, see exhibit labeled, 'Exterior Doors – November 2015.' See attached plans.

 - Additions (page 39) Additions to the rear of existing structures that are neither taller nor wider than the original structure may be eligible for administrative approval.


- > This Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) indicates that this project proposal has been determined to comply with the standards and policies of the Charlotte Historic District Commission.

- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.


This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.




















EXTERIOR ELEVATIONS
