DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: Commercial sign. The project is a non-illuminated commercial monument-style sign that will not exceed six feet in height. The sign will have a brick base match the primary structure and be lit with unobtrusive ground-mounted spotlights. The sign will be located in the front yard to the left of the walkway and brick steps. The sign itself will be made of an acrylic material and will have a total area of ten square feet.

This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.


