DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: Window Addition and Deck. A window will be added in brick foundation wall on the driveway side of the house for required egress. See exhibit labeled 'Proposed Location of Foundation Wall Window December 2015'. The window will match other added foundation windows. See exhibit labeled 'Existing Foundation Wall Windows December 2015'. Wooden rear deck will be expanded by ten feet to the rear. Wrap side dimension has been reduced. See exhibit labeled 'New Deck December 2015'. New deck rail will either match historic rail of house or be of historic proportions and details. Deck will be painted or stained.

Applicable: Policy & Design Guidelines – Decks and Windows and Doors.

- > This Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) indicates that this project proposal has been determined to comply with the standards and policies of the Charlotte Historic District Commission.
- > Display the blue COA placard in a visible location along with any required permits.
- No other approvals are to be inferred.
- > No demolition other than that specifically indicated on any attached plans is authorized under this approval.
- All work must be completed in accordance with all other applicable state and local codes.
- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.

This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.


