Details of Proposed Request

Existing Context

The structure is a one story ranch style building constructed in 1955 located at the corner of South Tryon St. and West Park Av. The building is used for commercial/office.

Proposal

The project is the installation of a wheelchair ramp at the front entrance. The ramp material is wood. The site plan includes a landscaping plan and parking location.

Policy & Design Guidelines - Additions, page 36

Additions to existing structures in Local Historic Districts have a responsibility to complement the original structure. Additions should reflect the design, scale and architectural style of the original structure. The following guidelines are intended to encourage addition designs that are compatible with the existing structure, while not fully mimicking the original design.

All additions will be reviewed for compatibility by the following criteria:	
a. Size	the relationship of the project to its site
b. Scale	the relationship of the building to those around it
c. Massing	the relationship of the building's various parts to each other
d. Fenestration	the placement, style and materials of windows and doors
e. Rhythm	the relationship of fenestration, recesses and projections
f. Setback	in relation to setback of immediate surroundings
g. Materials	proper historic materials or approved substitutes
h. Context	the overall relationship of the project to its surroundings

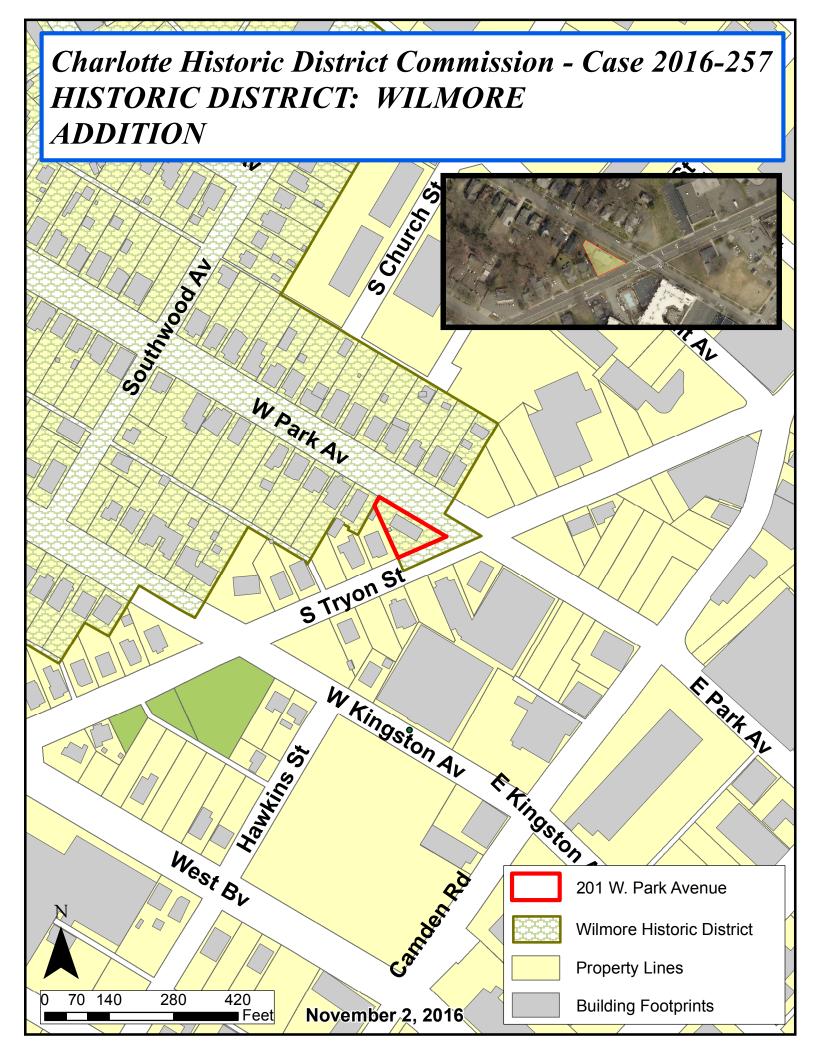
- 2. Additions must respect the original character of the property, but must be distinguishable from the original construction.
- 3. All additions to the front or side of existing properties must be of a design that is sensitive to the character and massing of the existing structure.
- 4. Additions to the front or side of existing structures that are substantially visible from a street must go before the full Commission.

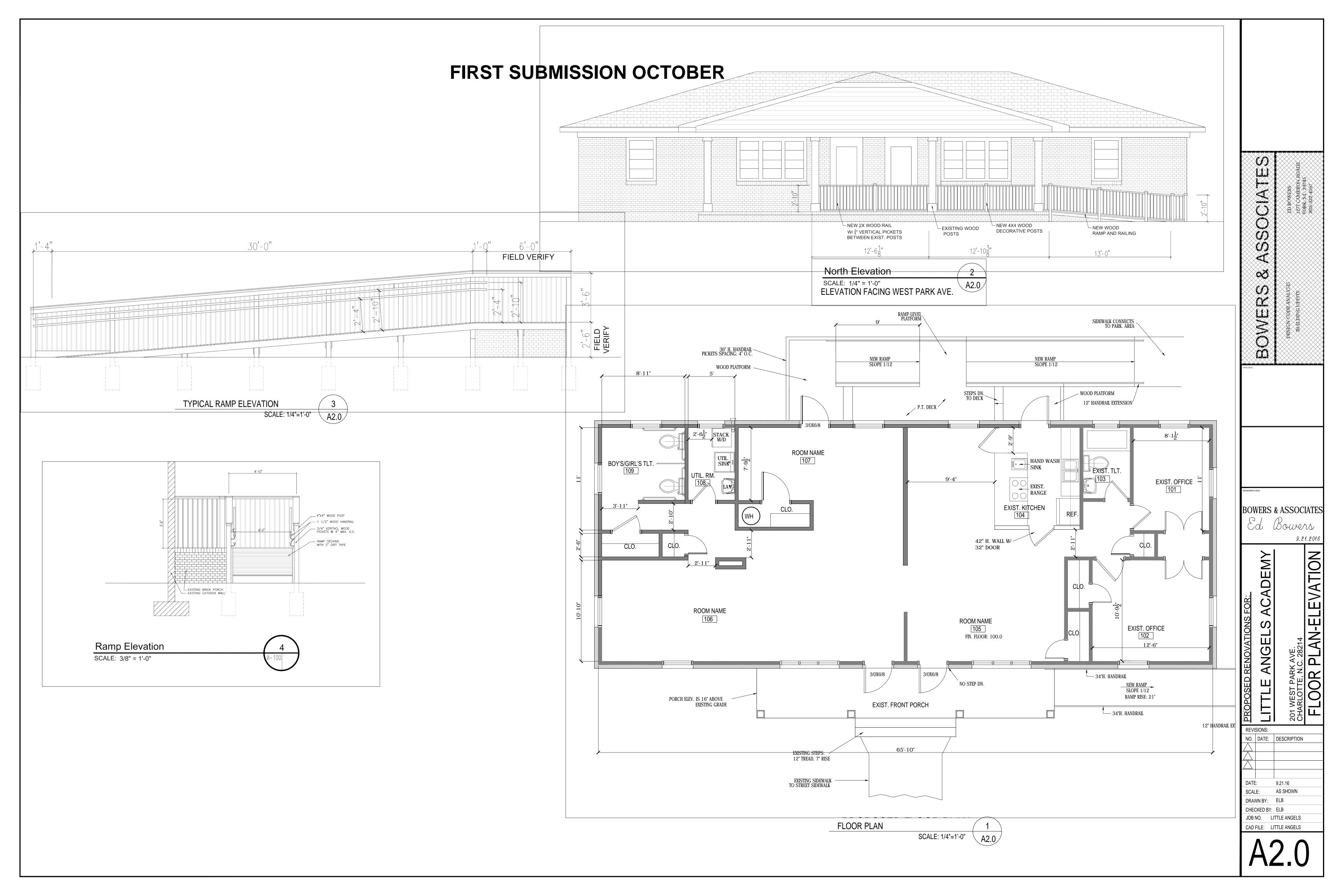

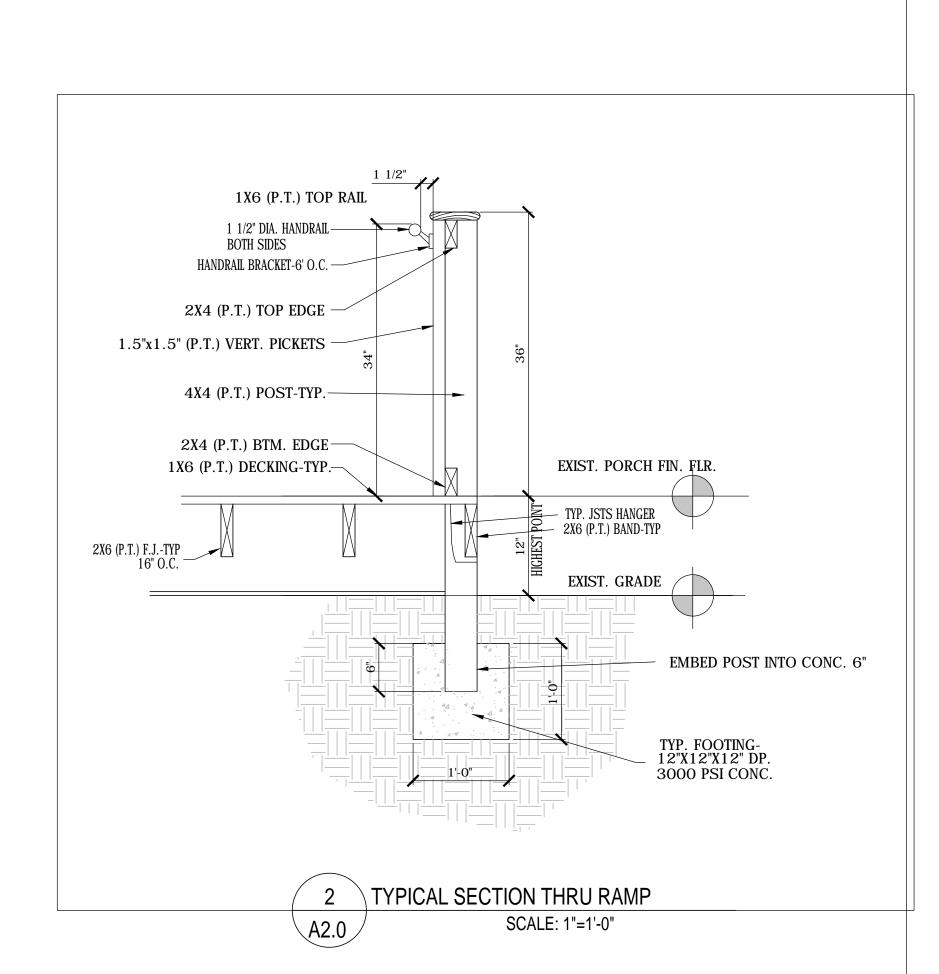


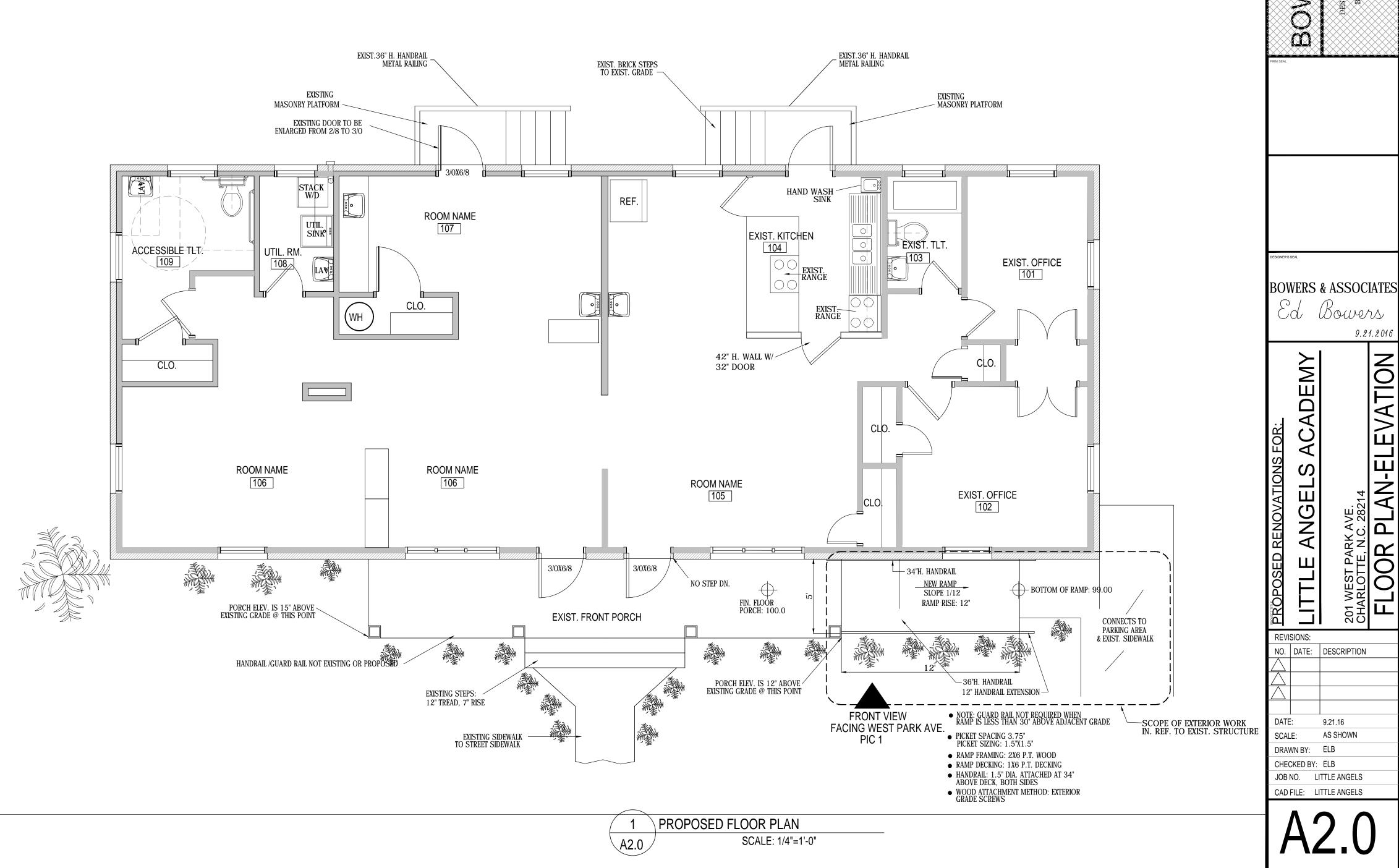








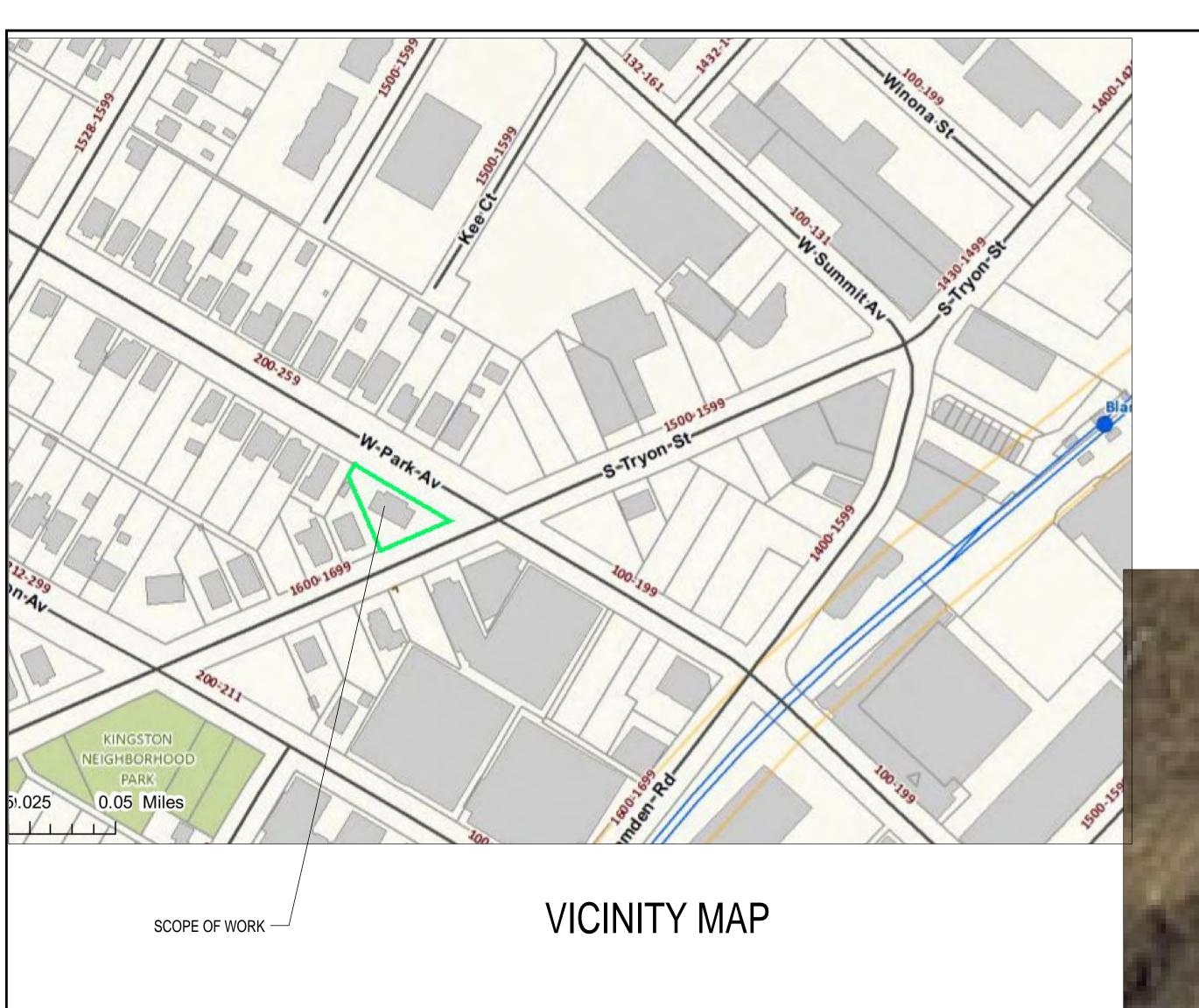




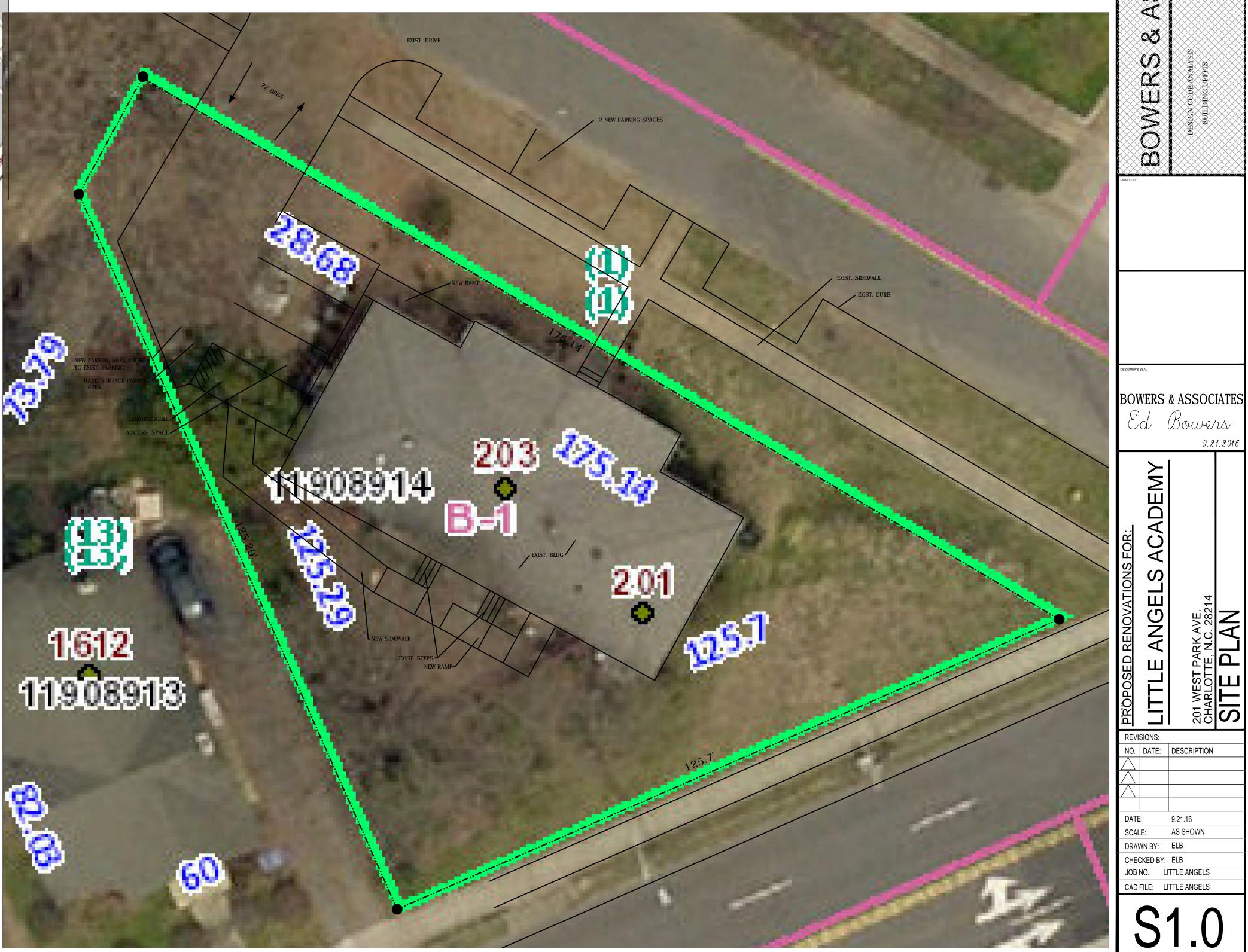
O1 WEST PARK AVE. HARLOTTE, N.C. 28214

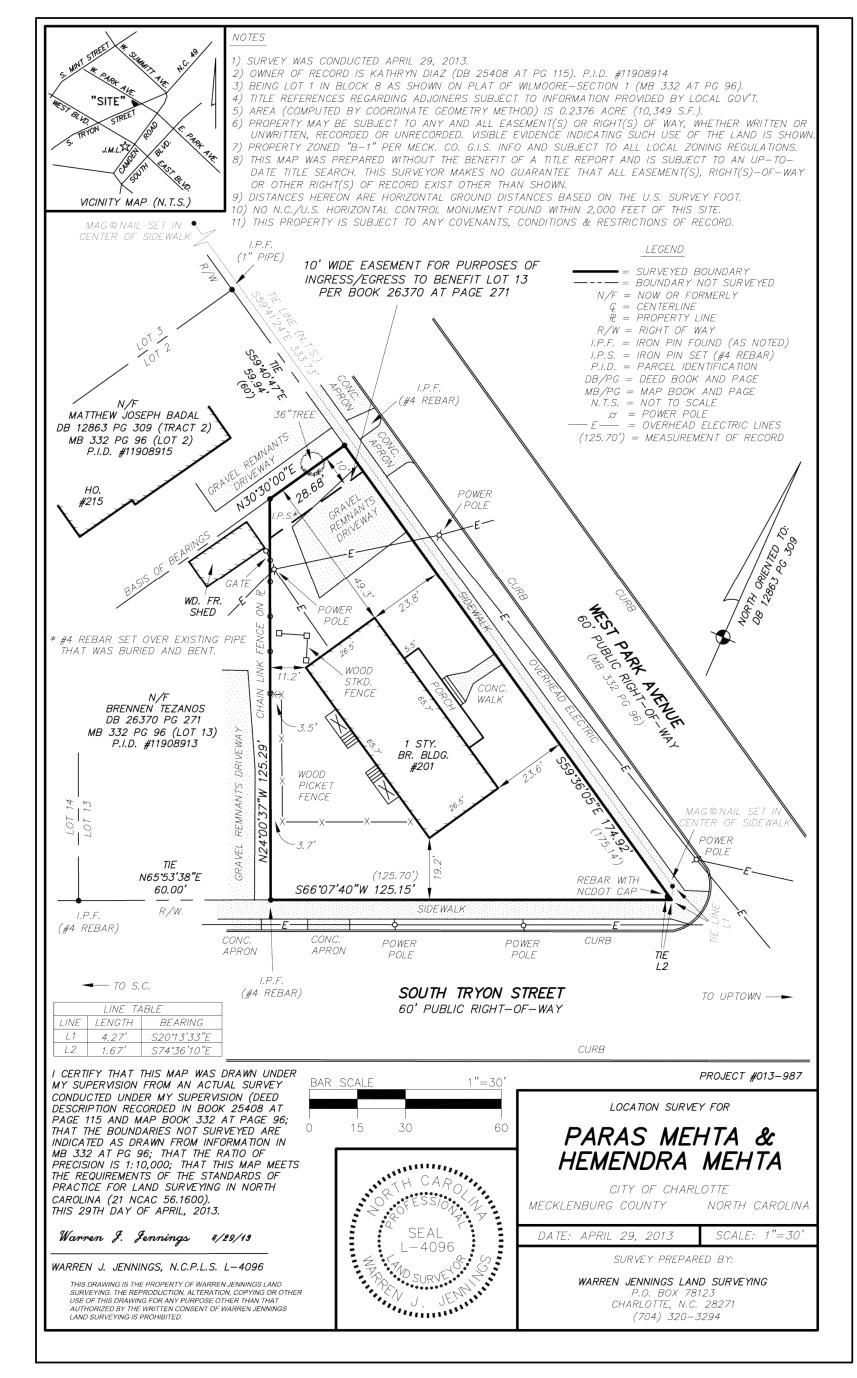

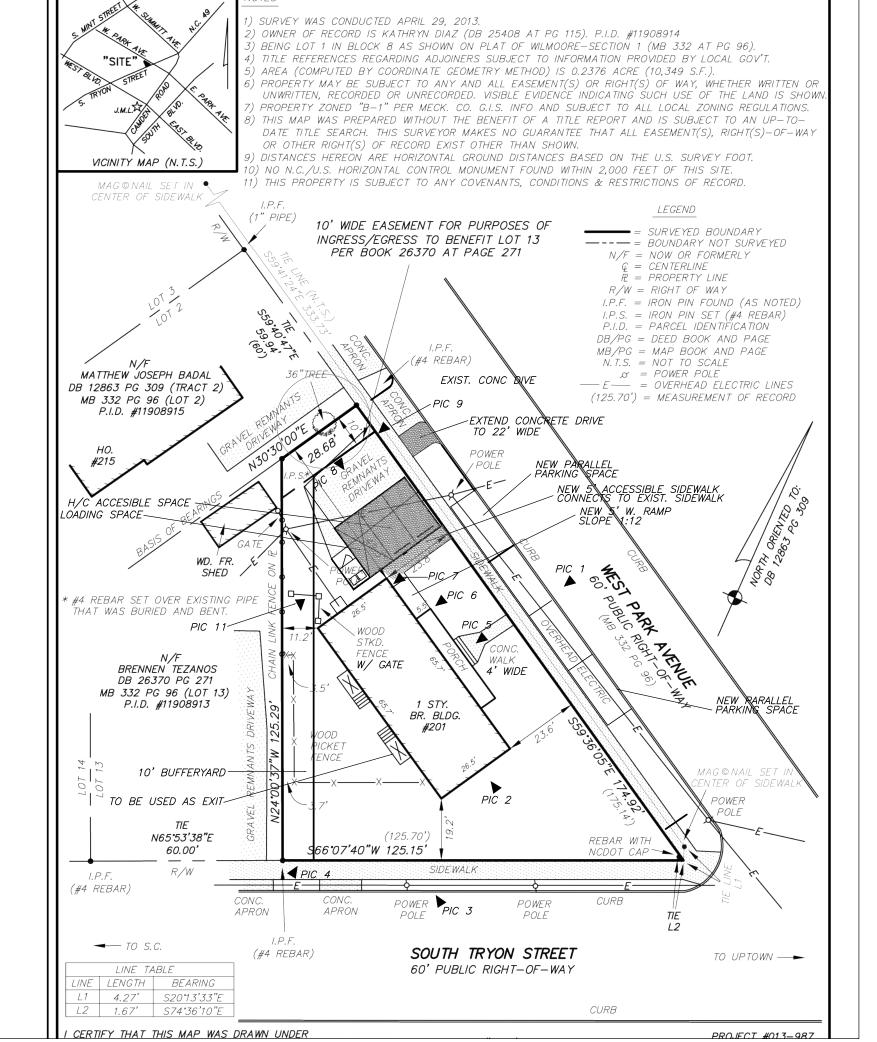

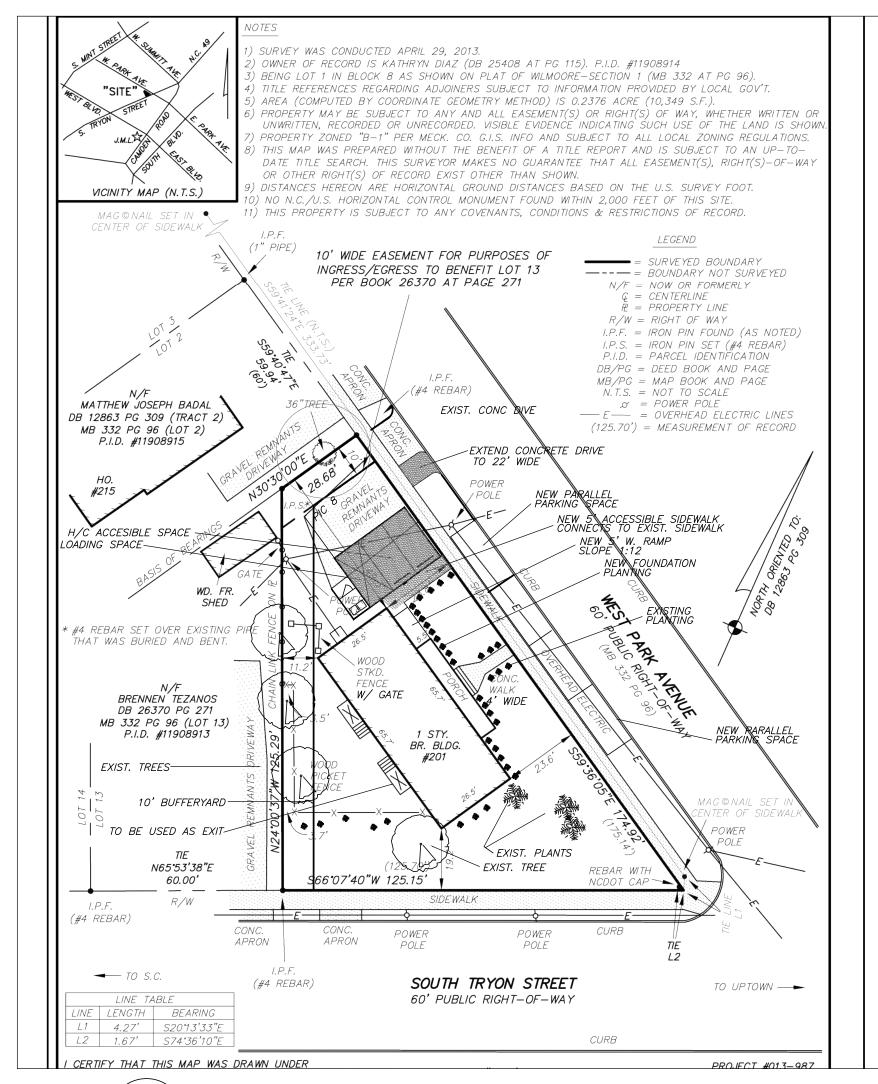
