**DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT:** Rear Deck. Wooden 12'x15' deck will be added to left rear of house. See exhibit labeled 'Site Plan January 2016'. Stair will be perpendicular to the back of the house. Landing will be on the corner at the back of the deck. The deck height will be above the door which allows access to the basement. Framed off, stick built lattice panels will be added below deck floor all around and a like panel will be added for privacy at the end of the deck. Some of the lower panels may be hinged to allow access to the area beneath the deck. Deck and lattice will be stained or painted. See exhibit labeled 'Lattice Work'. NOTE: Rail on plans is drawn correctly. See exhibit labeled 'Deck January 2016'.

## Applicable Policy & Design Guidelines Rear Yards page 64

- The Commission may allow Staff Approval of work in rear yards that will not be substantially visible from a street. This includes fencing, landscaping, driveways, parking pads, decks, patios, pools, and additions that are neither wider nor taller than the present house.
- > This Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) indicates that this project proposal has been determined to comply with the standards and policies of the Charlotte Historic District Commission.
- > Display the blue COA placard in a visible location along with any required permits.
- No other approvals are to be inferred.
- No demolition other than that specifically indicated on any attached plans is authorized under this approval.
- > All work must be completed in accordance with all other applicable state and local codes.
- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.

This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month
