DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: The project is a swimming pool in the rear yard. The new swimming pool/spa and coping will measure approximately 810 square feet. The pool equipment will be located within an existing brick and wood enclosure. No pool decking will be installed at this time. Based on the proposed size of the pool and size of the existing lot, the rear yard 50% impermeability limit is not exceeded. See attached exhibit labeled 'Site Plan – July 2016' and 'Pool Design – July 2016.'

- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.



Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within twelve (12) months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. In either situation, the Certificate can be renewed for an additional twelve (12) months by Historic District Commission staff by written request within the first twelve (12) months from the date of issuance.
