

DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: The project is the installation of three new storm doors on existing exterior entry doors. The new storm doors will be factory clad in a color to match the door trim or color of the door. The project also includes ordinary repair and maintenance to existing vinyl soffit and aluminum clad fascia, and existing wood stair treads, which does not require approval.

1. Applicable Policy & Design Guidelines and Approval Authority – Projects Eligible for Administrative Approval-Additions, page 2.6: Replacement Windows and Doors.
2. The applicable Policy & Design Guidelines for Front Doors and Entrances (page 4.10) have been met.

This Certificate is valid for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within twelve (12) months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. In either situation, the Certificate can be renewed for an additional twelve (12) months by Historic District Commission staff by written request within the first twelve (12) months from the date of issuance.
