**DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT:** Windows. The project is the replacement of two windows and the addition of one. The new double-hung window will be added to the center of the left elevation gable. The new window is wood with Simulated True Divided Light (STDL) 7/8" molded muntins in a 6/6 pattern and will match existing in size and trim. Replacement window one will be in the front gable and will be wood with Simulated True Divided Light (STDL) 7/8" molded muntins to match existing in size and trim. Replacement window two will be on the right elevation and will be a 4'x 2' wood casement window with Simulated True Divided Light (STDL) 7/8" molded muntins to match existing in size and trim. See exhibit labeled "Window -March 2019"

- 2. The applicable Design Guidelines for Windows (page 4.14) have been met.

This Certificate is valid for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within twelve (12) months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. In either situation, the Certificate can be renewed for an additional twelve (12) months by Historic District Commission staff by written request within the first twelve (12) months from the date of issuance.
