DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: Deck Replacement. This project is a replacement deck attached to the rear of a secondary dwelling behind the main structure. The replacement deck will be 10'x10' and will comply with all residential building code; including but not limited to obtaining a building permit. The second-floor replacement deck will move 18" to 20" in from the right-side elevation (if facing the deck) to come into compliance with zoning code and setbacks. The primary material will be treated wood on wood posts with 12" footings. The stairs and railings (36" tall with a max spacing of 4") will also be rebuilt to code.

This Certificate is valid for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within twelve (12) months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. In either situation, the Certificate can be renewed for an additional twelve (12) months by Historic District Commission staff by written request within the first twelve (12) months from the date of issuance.
