### Key Points:

- In the last decade Mecklenburg County grew by 224,174, a growth rate of 32.2%.
- Charlotte saw the largest increase of 190,596 people, a growth rate of 35.2%
- Charlotte population as a proportion of the county's total population increased from 77.8% in 2000 to 79.5% in 2010.
- The population of both Cornelius and Pineville doubled since 2000.
- Only 5.2% of the population live in an unincorporated area of Mecklenburg County.
