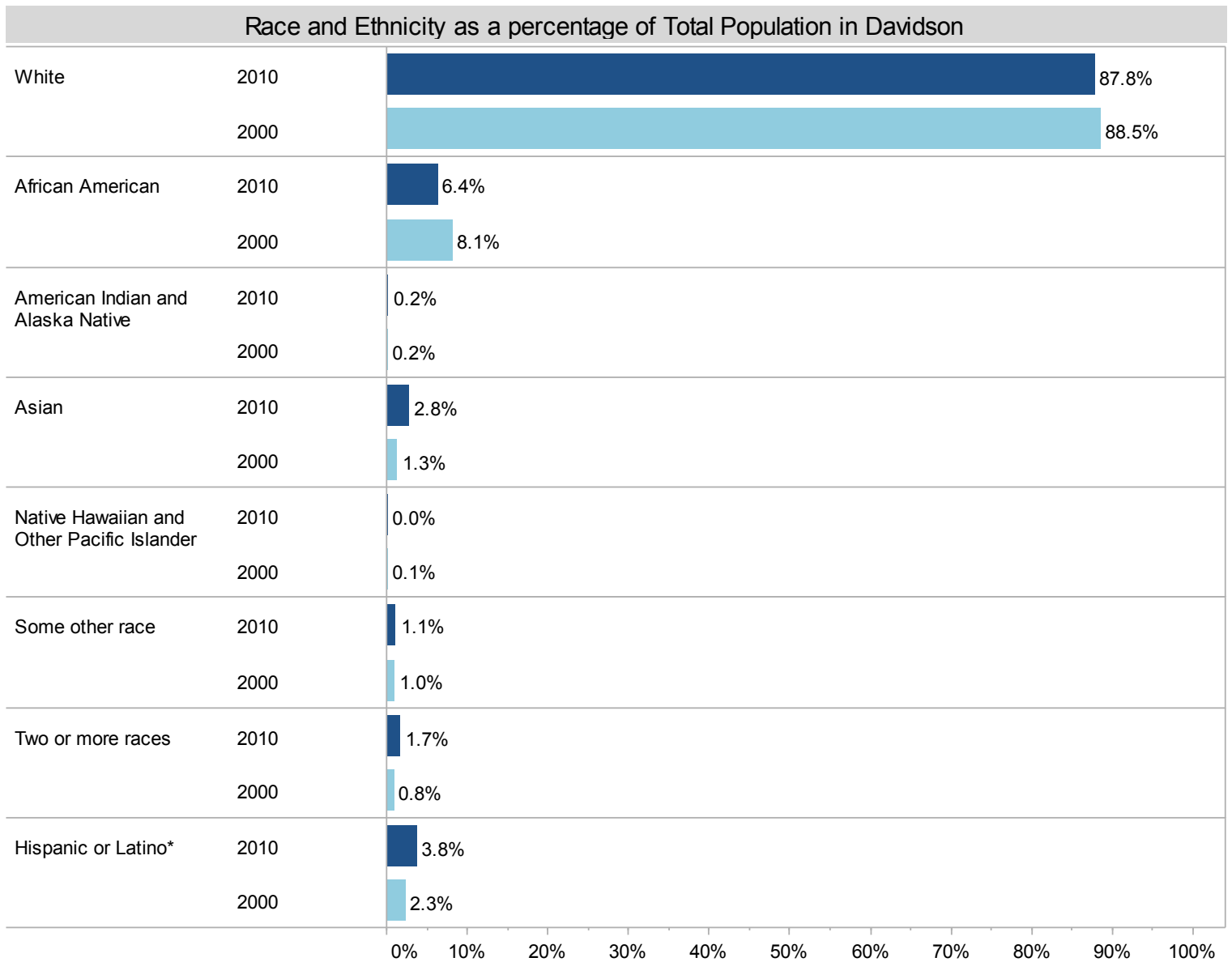


# CENSUS 2010 Population Profile: Town of Davidson



\*Hispanic or Latino Origin--This category is not included in the total since persons of Hispanic or Latino origin may be of any race.

## Key Points:

- While still the majority, White population as a proportion of the town's total population declined from 88.5% in 2000 to 87.8% in 2010.
- African American population, which accounted for 8.1% of total population in 2000 now makes up 6.4% of the town's residents.
- Asian population, which made up 1.3% of the town's total in 2000 now accounts for 2.8% of Davidson's total population.
- People of Hispanic or Latino origin now comprise 3.8% of the town's total population, compared to 2.3% in 2000.

### Key Points:

- In the last decade Davidson grew by 3,805, a growth rate of 53.3%.
- Whites saw the largest increase of 3,289 people.
- Asians saw the second largest population gain of 213.
- Asian population increased from 1.3% to 2.8% between 2000 and 2010, this is a percent change of 231.5%.
- Hispanic population grew by 248 to 3.8% of total population in 2010 from 2.3% in 2000.
