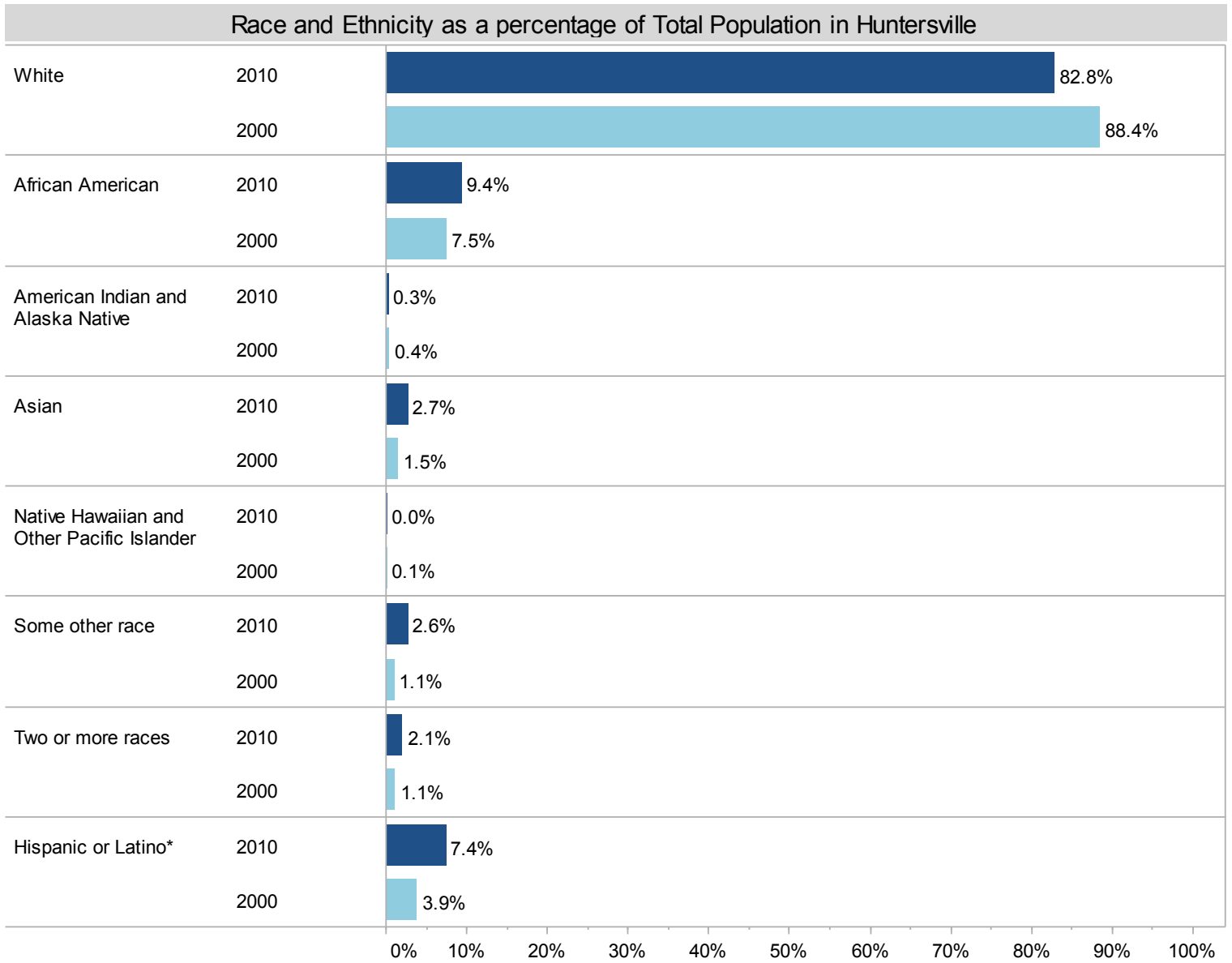


# CENSUS 2010 Population Profile: Town of Huntersville



\*Hispanic or Latino Origin--This category is not included in the total since persons of Hispanic or Latino origin may be of any race.

## Key Points:

- While still the majority, White population as a proportion of the town's total population declined from 88.4% in 2000 to 82.8% in 2010.
- African American population, which accounted for 7.5% of total population in 2000 now makes up 9.4% of the town's residents.
- Asian population, which made up 1.5% of the town's total in 2000 now accounts for 2.7% of Huntersville total population.
- People of Hispanic or Latino origin now comprise 7.4% of the town's total population, compared to 3.9% in 2000.

### Key Points:

- In the last decade Huntersville grew by 21,813, a growth rate of 87.4%.
- Whites saw the largest increase of 16,660 people.
- African Americans saw the second largest population gain of 2,539.
- Asian population increased from 1.5% to 2.7% between 2000 and 2010, this is a percent change of 234.2%
- Hispanic population grew by 2,473 to 7.4% of total population in 2010 from 3.9% in 2000.
