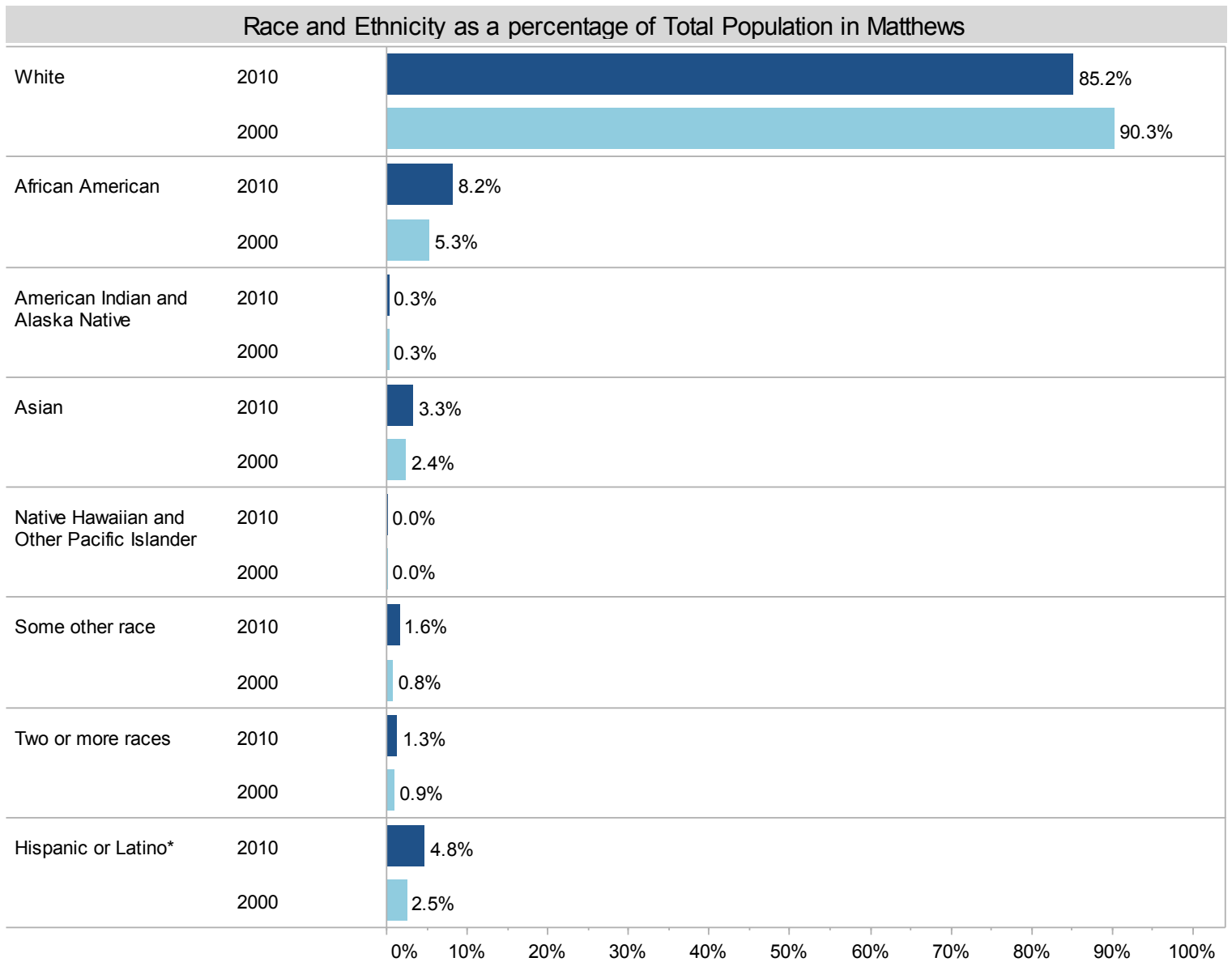


# CENSUS 2010 Population Profile: Town of Matthews



\*Hispanic or Latino Origin--This category is not included in the total since persons of Hispanic or Latino origin may be of any race.

## Key Points:

- While still the majority, White population as a proportion of the town's total population declined from 90.3% in 2000 to 85.2% in 2010.
- African American population, which accounted for 5.3% of total population in 2000 now makes up 8.2% of the town's residents.
- Asian population, which made up 2.4% of the town's total in 2000 now accounts for 3.3% of Matthews total population.
- People of Hispanic or Latino origin now comprise 4.8% of the town's total population, compared to 2.5% in 2000.

### Key Points:

- In the last decade Matthews grew by 4,321, a growth rate of 19.5%.
- Whites saw the largest increase of 2,554 people.
- African Americans saw the second largest population gain 992.
- Asian population increased from 2.4% to 3.3% between 2000 and 2010, this is a percent change of 68.1%.
- Hispanic population grew by 712 to 4.8% of total population in 2010 from 2.5% in 2000.
