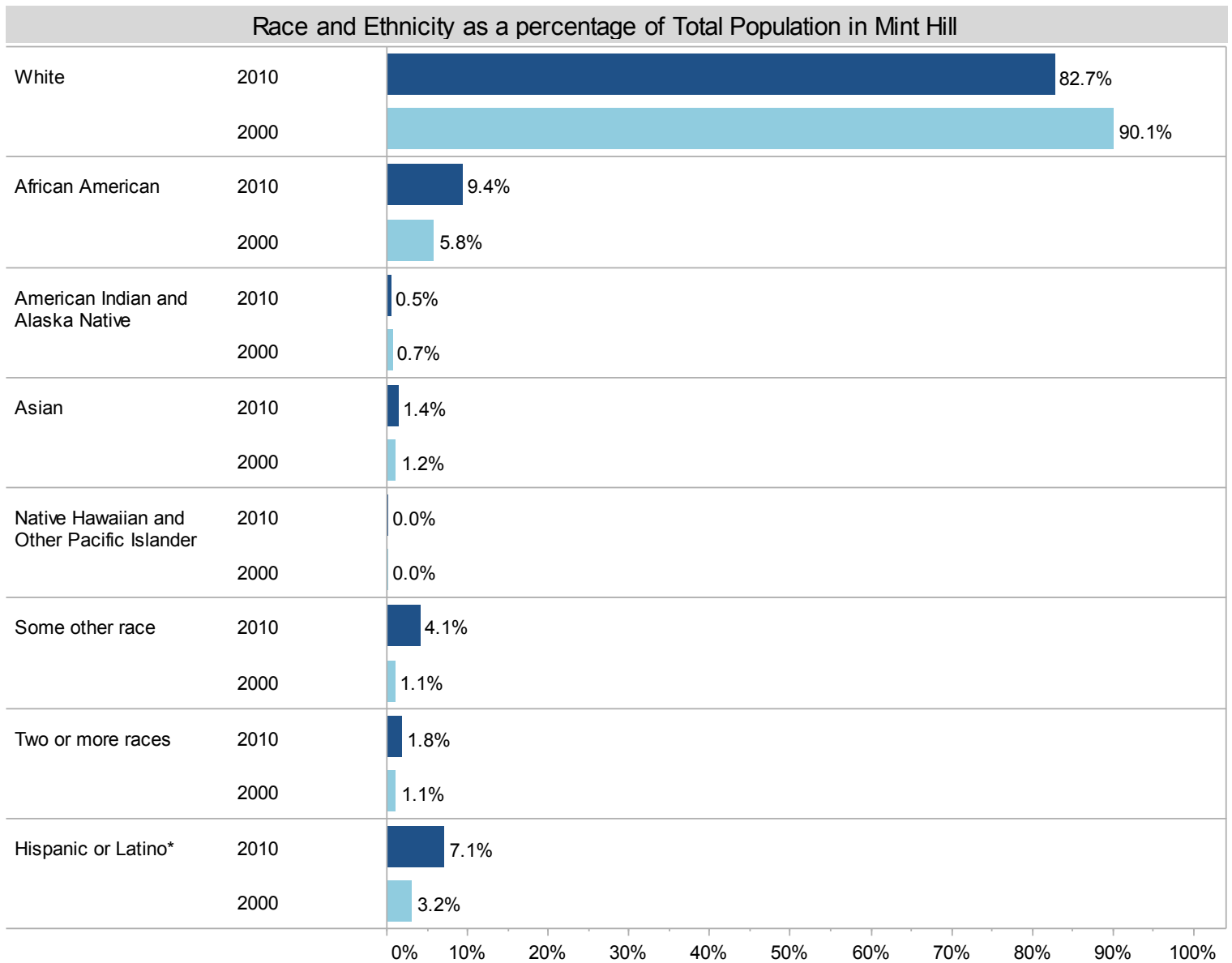


CENSUS 2010 Population Profile: Town of Mint Hill



*Hispanic or Latino Origin--This category is not included in the total since persons of Hispanic or Latino origin may be of any race.

Key Points:

- While still the majority, White population as a proportion of the town's total population declined from 90.1% in 2000 to 82.7% in 2010.
- African American population, which accounted for 5.8% of total population in 2000 now makes up 9.4% of the town's residents.
- Asian population, which made up 1.2% of the town's total in 2000 now accounts for 1.4% of Mint Hill's total population.
- People of Hispanic or Latino origin now comprise 7.1% of the town's total population, compared to 3.2% in 2000.

Key Points:

- In the last decade Mint Hill grew by 4,712, a growth rate of 31.6%.
- Whites saw the largest increase of 2,801 people.
- African Americans saw the second largest population gain of 978.
- Asian population increased from 1.2% to 1.4% between 2000 and 2010, this is a percent change of 61%
- Hispanic population grew by 928 to 7.1% of total population in 2010 from 3.2% in 2000.
