The property is located south of proposed Long Creek Greenway in the North Park Region. As previously agreed upon, the petitioner has noted a 30-foot easement off Amber View Court to MCPR. MCPR appreciates and accepts the easement, and requests that grading within the easement allow for an ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act)-accessible trail with slopes of 8% or less, if at all possible.
