

<b>REQUEST</b>	Current Zoning: B-1, neighborhood business Proposed Zoning: TOD-M, transit oriented development, mixed-use
<b>LOCATION</b>	Approximately 0.24 acres located on the east side of South Boulevard near the intersection of Rensselaer Avenue and South Boulevard. (Council District 1 – Maddalon)
<b>SUMMARY OF PETITION</b>	The petition proposes to allow all uses permitted within the TOD-M (transit oriented development – mixed use) zoning district.
<b>PROPERTY OWNER PETITIONER AGENT/REPRESENTATIVE</b>	Thomas Robert, LLC Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Department Bob Beausoleil
<b>COMMUNITY MEETING</b>	Meeting is not required.
<b>STATEMENT OF CONSISTENCY</b>	This petition is found to be consistent with the <i>South End Transit Station Area Plan</i> and to be reasonable and in the public interest based on information from the staff analysis and the public hearing, by a 6-0 vote of the Zoning Committee (motion by Commissioner Allen seconded by Commissioner Ryan).
