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**Comments:**

In relation to the parcels under review, Charlotte Water has water system infrastructure accessible via the existing 6-inch water mains along Cherry Street and East 1<sup>st</sup> Street.

In relation to the parcel under review, Charlotte Water has sanitary sewer system infrastructure accessible via the existing 8-inch gravity sewer mains along Cherry Street, East 1<sup>st</sup> Street, and Luther Street. There is also an existing 8-inch gravity sewer main within parcel under review. Developer should contact Charlotte Water's Installation & Development Services for information regarding development around this gravity main. This local gravity collection system was determined to have limited sanitary sewer system capacity. Additional development needs have triggered a detailed assessment of the basin to determine a public project. The applicant is encouraged to contact Charlotte Water's New Services Group at (704) 432-5801 to discuss an application for a Willingness to Serve or Capacity Assurance.

Development is encouraged to contact Installation Development Services (704) 336-5499 to review service connection design requirements and City Ordinances (e.g., backflow, separate meter Ordinance, public/private pipeline extensions).

Reservation of sanitary sewer system capacity through the Charlotte Water's Capacity Assurance Program is the responsibility of the customer/development. Contact the New Services Group at (704) 432-5801 for further information on reserving capacity up to 12 months.
