Proposed Zoning: B-1 (CD)

Location of Property: Approximately 1.85 acres located on the northeast corner at the intersection of Brookshire Blvd and N Hoskins Road.

Recommendations

Concerning Storm Water: Flooding and surface water quality impacts associated with impervious surfaces on this site are being addressed through compliance with the Post-Construction Stormwater Ordinance. Compliance may include installing devices that hold and slowly release runoff over time to reduce flooding potential, devices that filter pollutants from runoff before release to streams, preservation of vegetated stream buffer zones, preservation of upland trees and forested areas, or paying a mitigation fee in-lieu-of onsite stormwater control devices. Compliance with the Post-Construction Stormwater Ordinance addresses concerns related to flooding and surface water impacts and therefore staff has no further comments.

Recommendations

Due to revisions:

The proposed rezoning plan sheet indicates a proposed location for storm water management.
