TECHNICAL

2. The development of the Site will be governed by the Rezoning Plan, these Development Standards and the applicable provisions of the City of Charlotte Zoning Ordinance (the "Ordinance"). Subject to the optional provisions set out below, the regulations established under the Ordinance for the TOD-R zoning district shall govern the development and use of the Site.

3. The development and uses depicted on the Rezoning Plan are schematic in nature and are intended to depict the general arrangement of such uses and the improvements on the Site. Accordingly, the ultimate layout, locations and sizes of the development and site elements depicted on the Rezoning Plan are graphic representations of the proposed development and site elements, and they may be altered or modified in accordance with the setback and yard requirements set forth on this Rezoning Plan and the development standards, provided, however, that any such alterations and modifications shall not materially change the overall design intent depicted on the Rezoning Plan.

4. Future amendments to the Rezoning Plan and/or these Development Standards may be applied for by the then owner or owners of the Site in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Ordinance. Alterations to the Rezoning Plan are subject to Section 6.207 of the Ordinance.

B. <u>Permitted Uses</u>

1. The Site may be devoted only to a residential community containing a maximum of 18 single family attached dwelling units and to any incidental and accessory uses relating thereto that are allowed in the TOR-R zoning district.

C. Optional Provisions

The optional provisions set out below shall apply to the development of the Site.

1. The Site shall not be required to meet the minimum residential density and/or the minimum floor area ratio requirements of the TOD-R zoning district.

2. The public street to be constructed along the Site's eastern boundary line that shall terminate at the Site's northern boundary line may be constructed in accordance with the cross section depicted on the Rezoning Plan, and the width and location of the right of way to be dedicated to accommodate this public street shall be as depicted on the Rezoning Plan.

adjustments to the location of the internal private drive shall be allowed during the construction permitting process. The internal private drive may be constructed as a woonerf-style motor court.

3. Internal sidewalks and pedestrian connections shall be provided on the Site as generally depicted on the Rezoning Plan. The internal sidewalks may meander to save existing trees.

E. Architectural Standards

The maximum height in stories of the single family attached dwelling units to be located on the Site shall be 3 stories, plus possible rooftop terraces.

4. The maximum height in feet of each building containing single family attached dwelling units shall be 50 feet as measured from the average grade at the base of the building.

A minimum 8 foot wide planting strip and a minimum 8 foot wide sidewalk shall be installed along the Site's frontage on West Tremont Avenue as generally depicted on the Rezoning Plan. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the width of the planting strip and the width of the sidewalk may be reduced as required where the sidewalk ties into the existing sidewalk located on the Site's western and eastern boundary lines.

G. <u>Lighting</u>

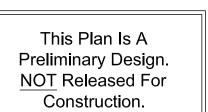
All freestanding lighting fixtures installed on the Site (excluding lower, decorative lighting that may be installed along the driveways and sidewalks and landscaping lighting) shall be fully capped and shielded and the illumination downwardly directed so that direct illumination does not extend past any property line of the Site.

- 2. The maximum height of any pedestrian scale, freestanding lighting fixture installed on the Site, including its base, shall not exceed 21 feet.
- 3. Any lighting fixtures attached to the buildings to be constructed on the Site shall be decorative, capped and downwardly directed.

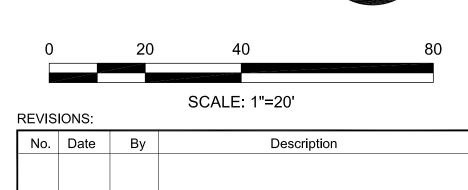
