## Development Data Table:

Existing Use: Single-family Residential
Proposed Uses: Up to twenty-seven (27) Townhome Units
Maximum Building Height: Fifty (50) feet; 3 stories
Parking: Shall satisfy or exceed UR-2 minimum requirements +/- 1.27 acres 091-091-01 and 091-091-02 R-5 and UR2(CD) UR-2(CD) and UR-2(CD) SPA

## I. General Provisions

These Development Standards form a part of the Rezoning Plan associated with the Rezoning Petition filed by Saussy LLC (the "Petitioner") to accommodate the development of a residential community on that approximately 1.27 acre site 1 the south-east side of East 36th Street and Spencer Street, more particularly depicted on the Rezoning Plan (the "Site"). Tomprised of Tax Parcel Numbers 091-091-01 and 091-091-02.

# Development of the Site will be governed by the Rezoning Plan, these Development Standards and the applicable provisions of the City of Charlotte Zoning Ordinance (the "Ordinance").

# Unless the Rezoning Plan or these Development Standards establish more stringent standards, the regulations established under the Ordinance for the UR-2 zoning district shall govern the development and use of the Site.

# The development and uses depicted on the Rezoning Plan are schematic in nature and are intended to depict the general arrangement of such uses and improvements on the Site. Accordingly, the ultimate layout, locations and sizes of the development and site elements depicted on the Rezoning Plan are graphic representations of the proposed development and site elements, and they may be altered or modified in accordance with the setback, yard, landscaping and tree save requirements set forth on this Rezoning Plan and the Development Standards, provided, however, that any such alterations and modifications shall not materially change the overall design intent depicted on the Rezoning Plan.

The Site may be devoted only to a residential community containing a maximum of twenty-seven (27) townhome incidental and accessory uses relating thereto that are allowed in the UR-2 zoning district.

## The Petitioner may provide on-street parking along the Site's frontage of East 36th Street.

Vehicular access will be as generally depicted on the Rezoning Plan. The placements and configurations of the vehicular access points shown on the Rezoning Plan are subject to any minor modifications required to accommodate final site and construction plans and designs and to any adjustments required by CDOT for approval.

r shall dedicate in fee simple conveyance a right of way to the City of Charlotte, set at two (2) feet behind the along Spencer Street and East 36th Street, before the site's first building certificate of occupancy is issued.

- Architectural standards for the townhome units shall consist of the following:
- The townhome units fronting East 36th Street shall face toward East 36th Street and units fronting Spencer Street shall face toward Spencer Street.

Preferred Exterior Building Materials: All principal and accessory buildings abutting East 36th Street shall comprise of a combination of portions of brick, natural stone (or its synthetic equivalent), stucco, cementitious siding, fiber cement ("HardiPlank") and/or other material approved by the Planning Director.

- Prohibited Exterior Building Materials:
- Vinyl siding (but not vinyl hand rails, windows or door trim); and
- To provide privacy, all residential entrances within 15 average sidewalk grade a minimum of twelve (12) inches feet of the sidewalk along East 36th Street shall be
- Pitched roofs, if provided, shall be symmetrically sloped no less than 5:12, except that roofs for porches and attached sheds may be no less than 2:12, unless a flat roof architectural style is employed.

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- Usable porches and stoops shall form a predominant feature of the building design and be located on the front and/or side of the building. Usable front porches shall be covered and be at least six (6) feet deep. Stoops and entry-level porches may be covered but should not be enclosed.
- The Petitioner will minimize the visual impact of any garage doors visible from the public or private to 24 inch setback from the front wall plane and adding additional architectural treatments such as projecting elements over the garage door opening. All corner/end units that face a public or private street shall have a porch or stoop that wraps a portion of the front and side of the unit or provide blank wall provisions that limit the maximum blank wall expanse to fifteen (15) feet on all building levels.
- Walkways of at least five (5) feet in width shall be provided to connect all residential entrances to sidewalks along public and private streets.
- Townhouse buildings should be limited to six (6) individual units

- The Petitioner shall provide a minimum eight (8) foot wide planting strip and a minimum six (6) foot wide sidewalk along the frontage on East 36th Street.
- Site and create lots within the Site with no

- Petitioner shall provide a minimum setback of at least twenty (20) feet from the existing back of curb of East 36th Street. and stairs may encroach four (4) feet into the setback as a "transition zone."
- Petitioner shall provide a minimum setback of at least twenty five (25) feet from the existing back of curb of Spencer Street
- Petitioner intends to provide an alternative streetscape plan along Spencer Street and East 36th Street, as shown on the site plan. However, if during the design and permitting phase of development it is determined that this alternative streetscape plan is not approved, the Petitioner will provide a streetscape plan in accordance with the City's typical streetscape standards.

The Petitioner shall comply with the Post Construction Controls Ordinance and tree save requirements.

VII.

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- All freestanding lighting fixtures installed on the Site (excluding lower, decorative lighting that may be installed along the driveways and sidewalks as landscaping lighting) shall be fully capped and shielded and the illumination downwardly directed so that direct illumination does not extend past any property line of the Site.
- The maximum height of any pedestrian scale, freestanding lighting fixture installed on the Site, including its base, shall not exceed fifteen (15) feet.
- Any lighting fixtures attached to the buildings to be constructed on the site shall be decorative, capped and downwardly directed.

Future amendments to the Rezoning Plan and these Development Standards may be applied for by the then Owner or Owners of a particular Tract within the Site involved in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Ordinance.

## Binding Effect of the Rezoning Documents and Definitions

If this Rezoning Petition is approved, all conditions applicable to development of the Site imposed under the Rezoning Plan and these Development Standards will, unless amended in the manner provided under the Ordinance, be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Petitioner and subsequent owners of the Site and their respective successors in interest and assigns.

Throughout these Development Standards, the terms, "Petitioner" and "Owner" or "Owners" shall be deemed to include the heirs, devisees, personal representatives, successors in interest and assigns of the Petitioner or the owner or owners of any part of the Site from time to time who may be involved in any future development thereof.
