#### **IMPACT UNDER CURRENT ZONING**

*Number of housing units allowed under current zoning:* the approximately 1.2 acres zoned B-1 and 0-2 would allow approximately 22 residential dwellings units.

The subject property is developed with an eating/drinking/entertainment establishment.

Number of students potentially generated under current zoning: 3 student(s) (1 elementary, 1 middle, 1 high)

## **IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT**

*Proposed Housing Units:* the MUDD (CD) conditional district request seeks to allow up to 30 residential units.

CMS Planning Area: 1, 2, 3

Average Student Yield per Unit: 0.1184

This development may add 4 student(s) to the schools in this area.

Construction of a new 45-classroom elementary school is slated to begin in June 2021 (tentative date).

2. Construction of additional classrooms will begin in June 2021 (tentative date).

The total estimated capital cost of providing the additional school capacity for this new development is \$81,000 calculated as follows:

Middle School: 1x \$37,000 = \$37,000

High School: 1x \$44,000 = \$44,000



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## **RECOMMENDATION**

Adequacy of existing school capacity in this area is a significant problem. We are particularly concerned about a rezoning case where school utilization exceeds 100% since the proposed development may exacerbate the situation. Approval of this petition may increase overcrowding and/or reliance upon mobile classrooms at the school(s) listed above.

Applicants are encouraged to contact us in advance of their project submittals to inform CMS of their prospective impacts and discuss mitigation alternatives.
