IMPACT UNDER CURRENT ZONING

Number of housing units allowed under current zoning: The conventional BP district allows all uses permitted in the district, including a mixture of employment uses. Residential dwellings are not allowed in the BP district.

The subject property is developed with one detached single family detached dwelling, one commercial structure (zoned B-1 (CD), The existing single family structure will be retained and converted for commercial use <u>or</u> may continue to be used as a residential structure.

IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Proposed Housing Units: The conditional **UR-2(CD)** district request seeks to allow up to 126 duplex dwelling units, along with permitted accessory uses.

Average Student Yield per Unit: 0.2718

This development may add 34 student(s) to the schools in this area.

The total estimated capital cost of providing the additional school capacity for this new development is \$1,072,000; calculated as follows:

Elementary School: 16x \$34,000 = \$544,000

High School: 12x \$44,000 = \$528,000



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RECOMMENDATION

Adequacy of existing school capacity in this area is a significant problem. We are particularly concerned about a rezoning case where school utilization exceeds 100% since the proposed development may exacerbate the situation. Approval of this petition may increase overcrowding and/or reliance upon mobile classrooms at the school(s) listed above.
