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| <b>Charlotte, NC</b>             | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100' to Residential use/district in UMUD, MUDD</li> <li>• 400' to Residential use and/or district in other districts</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Atlanta, GA</b>               | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 300' to Residential use</li> <li>• 300' to library, hospital, mental health care facility, tattoo parlor</li> <li>• 500' to church, park</li> <li>• 600' to schools, colleges, youth organization, recreational facility for children under 18.</li> <li>• If located in shopping center with 30,000+ sq. ft. and in which a library is located, exempt from separation.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Austin, TX</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 200' parking area to Residential unless in shopping center</li> <li>• 300' state law separation distance to churches, schools, day care</li> <li>• 540' to Residential requires CUP for Compatibility Development Standards.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Cincinnati, OH</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 10' buffer on side/rear yard if abut Residential district</li> <li>• 500' state law separation to schools, churches, libraries, public playgrounds, parks. These nearby uses can object to the sales of liquor within 30 days of notification.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Columbia, SC</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 400' to another drinking establishment</li> <li>• 600' to school or church</li> <li>• 300' state law to playground inside City.</li> <li>• 500' state law separation to playground if outside City limits.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Greenville, SC</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 300' state law separation to protected uses (church, school playground inside City.</li> <li>• 500' state law separation to same protected uses</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Indianapolis, IN</b>          | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100' to Residential and to Protected Districts (hospital, parks university, church or school districts)</li> <li>• 500' to commercial amusement/recreation establishment catering to people under 21.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Memphis/Shelby County, TN</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1500' separation to church, school, park, library, retail liquor store within City.</li> <li>• 500' to any church, school, park, library, retail liquor store in violation of the Zoning Ordinance, located in City.</li> <li>• 500' to Single Family Residential outside City limits.</li> <li>• 300' for beer to school, residence, church, public gathering place outside City limits.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Miami/Dade County FL</b>      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1500' from another existing business selling alcoholic beverages (except when cocktail lounge or bar is accessory to a restaurant in any industrial or commercial district).</li> <li>• 2,500' separation to churches and public schools.</li> <li>• Cocktail lounges or bars in restaurants may be exempt from separation distances if conditions are met.</li> <li>• Nightclubs in hotels and motels may be exempt from separation distances if conditions are met.</li> </ul> |

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| <b>Nashville/Davidson County Metro, TN</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 500' to Residential property</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Phoenix, AZ</b>                         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 500' separation to Residential district for Outdoor Recreation Uses, Outdoor Dining, and Outdoor Alcohol consumption.</li> <li>• 300' to Residential district for Bars over 5,000 sq. ft.</li> <li>• 300' to Residential district for Outdoor Preparation and Cooking areas.</li> <li>• 300' to Residential district for Bars and Cocktail lounges in shopping center districts</li> <li>• 300' to Residential district for Bars, Taverns, and Lounges in downtown core.</li> </ul> |
