1) A SIDEWALK SHALL BE PROVIDED ALONG THE SITE SIDE OF WOODLAWN ROAD WHICH WILL BE AT LEAST 6' IN WIDTH AND HAVE A PLANTING STRIP BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK AND THE STREET CURB OR EDGE OF PAVEMENT WHICH IS AT LEAST 8'

2) PLANTING STRIPS AND SIDEWALKS MAY BE LOCATED WITHIN THE SETBACK AND/OR THE RIGHTS-OF-WAYS SUBJECT TO ANY NECESSARY GOVERNMENT APPROVAL. 3) SIDEWALK CONNECTION TO ADJACENT PARCELS WILL BE PROVIDED ALONG THE EASTERN AND WESTERN PROPERTY BOUNDARY ALONG WOODLAWN ROAD. 4) A PUBLIC ACCESS AND MAINTENANCE EASEMENT WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THE SIDEWALK ALONG WOODLAWN ROAD THAT IS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

3) THE PLAN CALLS FOR A 20' RIGHT-OF-WAY DEDICATION AND CONVEYANCE ALONG WOODLAWN ROAD. THE DEDICATION AND CONVEYANCE WILL OCCUR PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS.

4) IF NECESSARY, AS DIRECTED BY NCDOT/CDOT, THE APPLICANT WILL AGREE TO MAKE REASONABLE EFFORTS TO ACQUIRE LANE IMPROVEMENTS. THE CURB AND GUTTER ALONG THE APPLICANTS FRONTAGE HAS BEEN SET TO ACCOMMODATE A ROAD SO THAT A BUILDING SETBACK CAN BE ESTABLISHED ON THE SITE PLAN. 2) PER CHAPTER 19 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE. THE INSTALLATION OF CURB, GUTTER AND SIDEWALK ARE REQUIRED ALONG THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT FOR REVIEW AND DECISION. THE PURPOSE OF THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL BE SUBMITTED TO ESTABLISHED TREE LINE BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT OF THE SITE AND EXISTING SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLINGS ALONG 20–30 TREES RANGING BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENTS ALONG DREXEL PLACE MAY RESULT IN THE REMOVAL OF APPROXIMATELY NOT HAVE IMPROVEMENTS MEETING CHAPTER 19 REQUIREMENTS FOR CURB, GUTTER AND SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO AND WITHIN PROXIMITY OF THE SITE.

3) NEIGHBORHOOD LEADERS AND RESIDENTS WHO LIVE ALONG DREXEL PLACE ARE OPPOSED TO THE INSTALLATION OF CURB, GUTTER AND SIDEWALK ALONG THIS PORTION OF THE STREET BASED ON AN APRIL 7, 2008 PUBLIC MEETING. THE REQUESTED IMPROVEMENTS ARE NOT ILLUSTRATED ON THE SITE PLAN BASED ON NEIGHBORHOOD OPPOSITION, BUT IF THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT DENIES THE CHAPTER 19 VARIANCE REQUEST, THE IMPROVEMENTS WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO THE CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS FOR REVIEW DURING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT PERMITTING PROCESS.

L) BINDING EFFECT OF THE REZONING APPLICATION

1) IF THIS REZONING PETITION IS APPROVED, ALL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO DEVELOPMENT OF THE SITE IMPOSED UNDER THESE DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND THIS TECHNICAL DATA SHEET WILL, UNLESS AMENDED IN THE MANNER PROVIDED SITE AND THE RESPECTIVE HEIRS, DEVISEES, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, SUCCESSORS IN INTEREST OR ASSIGNS. HEIRS, DEVISEES, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, SUCCESSORS IN INTEREST OR ASSIGNS. HEIRS, DEVISEES, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, SHALL BE DEEMED TO INCLUDE THE OWNER OR OWNERS OF THE SITE FROM TIME TO TIME WHO MAY BE INVOLVED IN ANY FUTURE DEVELOPMENT THEREOF.

N) NATURAL AREA DESIGNATION

1) THE PCCO NATURAL AREA IS GENERALLY DEPICTED ON THE PLAN BUT MAY ADJUST DUE TO GRACING HE OF THE NATURAL AREA IS APPROXIMATELY 11.37% OF THE TOTAL SITE. THE TREE SAVE AREAS ARE INCORPORATED INTO THE

O) PARKING DECK STANDARDS

1) THE PROPOSED PARKING DECK WILL COMPLY WITH SECTION 12.212 OF THE ORDINANCE.

1) THE PETITIONER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT OTHER STANDARD DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY OTHER CITY ORDINANCES, STANDARDS, POLICIES, AND APPROPRIATE DESIGN MANUALS WILL EXIST. 7) THE PETITIONER WILL SUBMIT A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN PRIOR TO INITIATING DEMOLITION AND/OR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES TO INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, THE PROCEDURES THAT WILL BE USED TO RECYCLE ALL CLEAN WOOD, METAL, AND CONCRETE GENERATED DURING DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. ALL LAND CLEARING AND/OR INERT DEBRIS WILL BE TAKEN TO A PROPERLY PERMITTED FACILITY. 

THE APPLICANT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACQUIRING ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY OR PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PAVEMENT ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF WOODLAWN ROAD IF NEEDED FOR SYMMETRICAL WIDENING.


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




EAST ELEVATION
