Proposed Request Details

This is a conventional rezoning petition with no associated site plan.

Existing Zoning and Land Use

The property is currently used as a warehouse. Properties surrounding the site are zoned TOD-M (transit oriented development - mixed-use) and developed with transit supportive uses or are zoned I-2 (general industrial) and developed with a mixture of industrial uses.

Rezoning History in Area

There have been numerous rezonings in this area to accommodate transit supportive uses.

Public Plans and Policies

- The New Bern Transit Station Area Plan (2005) recommends mixed transit supportive development for the property. The site is approximately a ½ mile walk from the New Bern Street Station.
- The petition is consistent with the New Bern Transit Station Area Plan.
