

Ordinance No. 1185

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE IV, Sec. 14-130 OF THE CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA, THAT:

Section 1: Chapter 14, Article IV, Sec. 14-130 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to operate, drive, stop, stand, or park a vehicle upon any sidewalk or sidewalk area. This provision shall not be applicable to non-motorized bicycles, electric assisted bicycles operated at a speed of no more than 15 miles per hour, and electric standup scooters, which may be operated on sidewalks, except as provided in section 14-251.

Section 2: This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

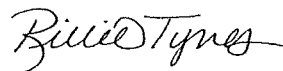

Chapter 14, Article IV, Sec. 14-130 of the City Code
