Fall, 2004:

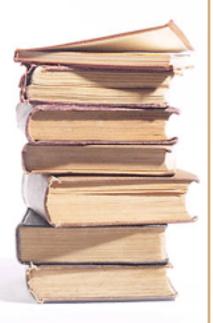
Overview of financing techniques that link development with school crowding:



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CMS School Facilities Master Plan Update

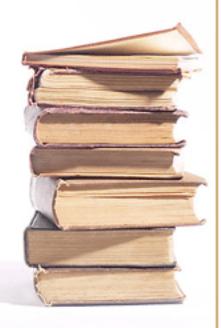
