

Update to "raise the bar" on standards, with a focus on design

Floor Area Ratio for Institutional Uses

 Confirm regulations that exempt parking decks for institutional uses from floor area ratio calculations, when in single family and multi-family districts

Cell Towers

 Update standards to address changes in technology and provide more location options

Mobile Vendors


 Consolidate regulations for mobile vendors – updating standards for mobile food trucks and developing standards for new uses such as mobile grocers








Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Update




