# Area Plan Policy Assessment – Scope

**Project Goal**: To assess the effectiveness of our existing land use policy structure and to develop recommendations to strengthen our policy development processes, products and implementation tools.

## ASSESS

## **A**NALYZE

Analyze information to develop goals for focus areas.



## **ACT**

Develop a plan of action to address short, medium and long terms policy goals.

## **PROCESS**

Broaden our toolbox for developing area plans.
Build upon recent process enhancements and incorporate new ideas from other communities.

## **PRODUCT**

Restructure our current format and content. Develop new print and web-based tools to communicate land use policies.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

Strengthen linkages between area plan vision and implementation tools. Develop new processes and regulatory tools to clearly articulate policy implementation process.

Offer a variety of planning initiative types to develop a vision


Link capital facilities planning to land use planning initiatives
