Details of Proposed Request

This proposal is for the replacement of the existing main identification sign for Hankins & Whittington Funeral Chapel. The existing sign is roughly the same size and scale as the proposed sign, and is designed to be compatible with the architecture of the funeral home and chapel. The new sign would be in the same location as the current sign. Because the present sign is larger than what is allowed for administrative approval, it must under HDC policy be approved by the full Commission.

Current Status and Context of Property

This property is located at the intersection of East Boulevard and Dilworth Road East, along the East Boulevard commercial corridor. There are no proposed changes to the existing structures or the site other than the sign replacement.

Relevant Secretary of Interior's Standards for Historic Rehabilitation

(As cited in the Charlotte Zoning Ordinance Section 10.210)

- (i) New additions, exterior alterations, or related new construction shall not destroy historic materials that characterize the property. The new work shall be differentiated from the old and shall be compatible with the massing, size, scale, and architectural features to protect the historic integrity of the property and its environment.
- (j) New additions and adjacent or new construction shall be undertaken in such a manner that if removed in the future, the essential form and integrity of the historic property and its environment would be unimpaired.





