DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: Signage. 3'6" x 2'4" aluminum sign will be installed. New monument sign will be mounted on base. House numbers will be applied to base. Total height will not exceed four feet. Two sided sign will be located in front lawn.

Applicable Policy & Design Guidelines: Signage - Page 65 - 70

- 1. All signs within a Local Historic Districts will require a Certificate of Appropriateness.
- 2. All signs should be primarily for identification purposes.
- 3. All signs must visually relate to the building they serve. Only suitable materials, such as stone, wood, brick, sand sturdy metals will be approved.
- 4. Sensitively designed supports may, if approved, e4xceed the square footage restrictions but not the height restrictions.
- 6, The HDC reserves the right to approve the placement of all signs on properties within Local Historic Districts.
- 8. Property addresses should be clearly displayed either on the sign or on the building.


The applicable *Policy &n Design Guidelines* are met by size, materials, location.

- This Certificate of Appropriateness indicates that this project proposal has been determined to comply with the standards and policies of the Charlotte Historic District Commission.
- No other approvals are to be inferred.
- > No demolition other than that specifically indicated on any attached plans is authorized under this approval.
- > All work must be completed in accordance with all other applicable state and local codes.
- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.

This Certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.
