DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT: Commercial sign. The project is a non-illuminated commercial sign attached to the front of the building in an engineered space above the front door, see attached exhibit labeled 'Sign Design – December 2015'. The sign is individual letters cut from 3/8" thick acrylic and painted. The letters will have a ¼" standoff with a total projection of 5/8" from the wall. The total area of the sign is 7.68 square feet. The building will not be altered to install the sign.

- Any changes from or additions or deletions to the plans referenced herein will void this Certificate, and a new application must be filed with the Historic District Commission.



Failure to obtain a building permit in that time will be considered as a failure to comply with the Certificate and the Certificate will become invalid. If a building permit is not required, then the approved work must be completed within six months of the date of issuance of this Certificate. The Certificate can be renewed within twelve months of its issuance by Historic District Commission staff by written request and submission of a valid reason for failure to comply within the six-month deadline.

Scale: 1"= 1"-0"




