**DETAILS OF APPROVED PROJECT:** Driveway and Gate. The project is the installation of a driveway and gate at the rear of the property. The existing gravel driveway and brick/paver surround will be replaced with a new concrete driveway in the same location as the current driveway. The new driveway will measure 15' x 35'. A planting strip of at least 12" will be left between the rear foundation of the house and the new concrete driveway. A new pre-finished arched-top aluminum 6' high gate will be installed at the end of the driveway. A pre-finished flat-top aluminum 6' high fence will connect the gate to the existing 6' wood fence on the right side of the drive and enclose the back yard. The existing wood picket fence that runs the length of the right side of the driveway will be removed along with the ~288 sf stamped concrete patio in the rear yard. Rear yard open space will be ~46% post construction. See attached exhibits labeled, 'Site Plan-Nov. 2019', 'Fence Design-Nov. 2019', Fence removal -Nov. 2019', and 'Patio removal — Nov. 2019'.

renewed for an additional twelve (12) months by Historic District Commission staff by written request within the first twelve (12) months from the date of issuance.


