What is the purpose of the Advisory Group?

The purpose of this group is to provide staff with input during the plan development process.

What is required to be a member of the Advisory Group?

No special skills or knowledge is required to participate in the Advisory Group; however, we are seeking a commitment from you to:

- Provide input during development of the plan.
- Follow meeting ground rules (see back of page).
- Attend six to ten meetings over the next five to six months (approximately two meetings monthly).
- Attend one or two additional Advisory Group meetings to review draft plan recommendations during early 2009.
- Review information and materials in advance of meetings and be prepared to discuss.

What if you cannot attend all the meetings?

If you are unable to make this commitment, you may still have input in the plan development process. Additional meetings will be held during the plan development process to receive public input and there will be public comment sessions before the Planning Committee of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Commission and City Council in early 2009.

The first Advisory Group meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday**, **August 19**th, **6:00 pm – 8:00 pm** in the Shady Brook Baptist Church – Fellowship Hall, 2940 Belmeade Drive.
