

In 2016, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Department will launch the Community Planning Academy pilot program, an educational initiative aimed at helping residents understand the role planning plays in building communities. The pilot program is open to all residents but the class size will be limited to 30 seats. Admissions will be based on including a mix of residents with diverse backgrounds, from different neighborhoods and with a range of planning experience.

The program consists of 7 monthly classes, beginning in March and running through September 2016. Classes will be held from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm on the first Tuesday of each month. Please consider this time commitment before applying to the program. Applications are due December 30, 2015. Staff will notify all applicants of admission decisions by the end of January 2016.
