## **Advisory Group Ground Rules**

- Attend all meetings. Commit to attend all meetings.

- **Identify yourself before speaking.** This will be helpful in learning names.
- Don't be afraid to ask questions.
- **Be courteous and polite.** Please don't interrupt others and limit side conversations. Everyone will have an opportunity to speak.
- Be brief and to the point. There is a lot of ground to cover.
- Make the distinction between fact and opinion.
- It's okay to be messy. Some issues are not cut and dry. It may be necessary to agree to disagree in order to confront issues.
- Strive for general consensus. Please come to the meetings with an open mind and be prepared to work towards agreement. In the event that consensus is not reached, more than one recommendation may go forward.
