Welcome and Introductions

Draft Vision Statement

Ms. McCullough led the discussion on drafting a vision statement for the Steele Creek area. She first shared some basic guidelines and considerations that are essential to the visioning process. Meeting participants were then asked to review and provide comments on two draft vision statements developed by staff. The vision statements were based on the community's input to date. Meeting participants favored Option 1 and requested that a statement be added to address the need for quality schools in the area.
