




### What is an Area Plan?

- Framework for future growth and development that updates the broader, more general District Plans.
- Policy guide for elected and appointed officals in making land use, zoning, and capital investment decisions.
- Community's shared vision for future.

### What can you expect from a Plan?



- Clarify vision for the area.
- Identify and provide policies to address development opportunities and issues.
- Identify public and private investments needed to achieve vision
- Update adopted Land Use for Area
- Possibly Recommend Zoning Changes
- Guide more appropriate development.

- City not a developer
- Immediate funding of recommendations
- Implement overnight
- Property to be rezoned
- Halt redevelopment


#### Existing Walking Distances









#### Northeast District Adopted Future Land Use














#### North Tryon – An Urban Boulevard







#### Vision & Goals









University City will be transformed into a distinct and vibrant peopleoriented place that is urban in scale and design.

It will be energized by a highly successful light rail line that will operate along the North Tryon corridor and will be a popular and accessible destination for people of all ages, income levels and backgrounds, offering diverse and unique choices for living, shopping, working, learning and enjoying leisure time.

- Promote and design North Tryon as the premiere Public space and gateway to University City.
- Encourage the development of a lively well designed corridor with a variety of housing types, retail, and employment uses with public spaces integrated to create a compact and "Walkable" Community.
- Encourage the development / Redevelopment of areas at the edge of the MSD that blend with adjacent uses, pedestrian oriented, and are transit supportive.
- Improve connectivity throughout the University City to reduce reliance on the major thoroughfares, encourage walking and bicycling and better connect existing institutions with the rest of the community.
- Create a network of public open spaces, parks and greenways to help define the public realm; and,
- Support a healthy natural environment.




The Character of a Road Influences the Quality of Urban Environment
















#### Recommended Land Use – Edge Areas




#### Property Along I-85 Balance Pedestrian Design with Interstate Businesses










### Bicycle Facilities and Greenways




#### Street Network & Road Classifications


