MANDATORY REFERRAL REPORT NO. 99-17 CHARLOTTE MECKLENBURG PLANNING COMMISSION ADDITIONAL PROPERTY NORTHWEST SCHOOL OF THE ARTS

PROJECT LOCATION

The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education proposes to purchase 1.322 acres of land (See Attached Map) adjacent to the Northwest School of the Arts. The proposed site has 145 feet of frontage along Beatties Ford Road and is zoned R-5.

PROJECT PROPOSAL

This proposed project calls for the purchase of 1.322 acres of vacant land (Tax Parcel Number 069-096-01) by the Board of Education to address overcrowding by allowing mobile classrooms to be placed adjacent to the school.

PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

The property is contiguous to the Northwest School of the Arts. The existing school site contains only 9.639 acres which is exceedingly small school site. The additional land will address overcrowding by allowing mobile classrooms to be placed adjacent to the school.

PROJECT IMPACT

The project would address overcrowding by allowing mobile classrooms to be placed adjacent to the school and would provide additional land to an undersized, existing school site.

PROJECT COST


The total cost of this project is estimated to be \$4,750 which is the appraisal value of the property.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION


Staff recommends purchase of the land to provide a site for the mobile classrooms to relieve overcrowding and add property to the undersized, existing campus. Please refer to the Zoning Ordinance, Section 9.203 (7) for the prescribed conditions for permitting mobile classrooms in residential districts.

PLANNING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

At the July 20,1999 meeting, Planning Committee unanimously approved the purchase of 1.322 acres of land adjacent to the Northwest School of the Arts for mobile classrooms. Planning Committee also stated that after one year all applicable <u>Buffer and Screening</u> requirements must be fully complied with in all areas occupied by mobile classroom.
