### **Summary of Petition**

This petition proposes to develop an 18-parcel business park. Improvements to the site include planting strips and sidewalks throughout the development, dedication to the greenway system and the potential redevelopment of some of the existing buildings currently located on the site. Uses are limited to those that will create the least amount of conflict between the industrial park and the surrounding residential properties.

### Zoning Committee Discussion/Rationale

Keith MacVean reviewed petition and noted that all outstanding site plan issues had been resolved. The petition is inconsistent with the Central District Plan but staff is recommending approval of the petition.

## **Statement of Consistency**

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Randolph and seconded by Commissioner Johnson the Zoning Committee unanimously found this petition to be inconsistent with the *Central District Plan* but reasonable and in the public interest.
