

### Summary of issues

- Concerns were voiced regarding the traffic patterns on The Plaza and potentially people using Aintree Rd for the means of U Turns.
   Many vehicles do this now and the concern is that number might go up.
- Vehicles turning left and right out of the driveway might cause traffic delays.
- Number of garbage bins might not be sufficient to hold the children's diapers and other waste. Acquisition of a container with odor control was suggested.



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### Pre-Public Hearing Community Meeting Attendee and Discussion List (contd...)

- What does this re-zoning do to the property values and taxes of the neighboring properties?
- o A question regarding the kids getting to the premises was raised.
- Would this re-zoning affect the neighborhood transition to "stable"
- o There were 27 accidents on The Plaza over the past 5 years.
- o Question regarding the soil condition was raised.
- Questions and suggestions on the size and shape of the signage were exchanged.
- The rezoning petition mentions that the application is for rezoning the 5012 The Plaza from Residential to Institutional with Conditional status – what does that Conditional status mean?
- o If the 5 star day care center goes out of business, can this property be turned into some other commercial business without a petition?
- o What shifts is the day care center going to operate?
- o Sound buffer behind the play area was suggested.

### Petitioner's response to the above questions

- Traffic: The two driveways will be connected so the traffic flow in and out of the premises will be smooth. The driveways will be oneway.
- An indentation will be made at the entrance and exit of the driveways so entering and exiting the premises will be easier.
- CDOT has noted the changes and has informed us of no further transportation issues with this petition.
- o More garbage bins will be purchased if needed
- The day-care will be using mini buses that will pickup and drop off many of the kids.
- The oil tanks and the top soil were removed in August and replaced with fresh soil by Salem Environmental. NC department of Environment has expressed their satisfaction in a letter dated August 29<sup>th</sup>.
- The signage will be small and will be certainly made to fit the neighborhood.
- Plants and shrubbery will be placed in between the outdoor play area and the neighboring property to provide sound buffering.
