Air Quality

The proposed project may be subject to certain air quality permit requirements in accordance with Mecklenburg County Air Pollution Control Ordinance (MCAPCO) Regulation 2.0805 - "Parking Facilities". A letter of notification and copy of the regulations will be mailed directly to the petitioner by MCAQ.

Development of this site may require submission of an asbestos Notification of Demolition and Renovation due to possible demolition or relocation of an existing

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structure or renovation of a load-bearing wall in an existing structure. This notification is required in accordance with the Mecklenburg County Air Pollution Control Ordinance (MCAPCO) Regulation 2.1110 - Subparagraph (a) - "National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants". A letter of notification and the required forms will be mailed directly to the parcel owner.
