

# Rezoning Petition 2013-026 PRE-HEARING STAFF ANALYSIS February 17, 2014

Note: Planning staff is requesting a deferral of this petition to the March 17, 2014 meeting to continue discussions with PED (pedestrian overlay) property owners, neighborhood leaders and other interested parties and consider making additional changes to the pedestrian overlay district. Additional changes would require this text amendment, originally heard on March 19, 2013, to have a new public hearing.

REQUEST Text amendment to Section 10.812 of the Zoning Ordinance

**SUMMARY OF PETITION** The petition proposes to clarify that there is no maximum density for

residential dwellings in the PED (pedestrian overlay) district.

**STAFF** Staff recommends deferral of this petition to allow additional changes

to the PED (pedestrian overlay) standards.

## Proposed Request Details

The text amendment contains the following provisions:

• Adds language to Table 10.812(1) to clarify that there is no maximum density for residential dwellings in the PED (pedestrian overlay) district. This addition will clarify that underlying zoning district regulations for density do not apply.
