The following restrictions shall apply to any outdoor dining patio located in a required setback of any Business Districts:

- 1. All outdoor dining areas shall be located behind the public sidewalk and out of the public right-of-way and on private property.
- 2. In respect to certain zoning districts may allow outdoor dining areas within the public right-of-way subject to obtaining a sidewalk dining right-of-way encroachment agreement through the Charlotte Department of Transportation (CDOT).
- 3. Outdoor dining areas within the required setback shall be located on a patio at grade and contain no temporary or permanent roof and roof supporting structures.
