

Community Meeting Report for Rezoning Petition No. 2015-030 (Cherry Site D)

Petitioner: Charlotte Housing Authority (CHA)

Rezoning Petition No. 2015-030

Property: 0.562 acres on Luther Street, between Baldwin Ave & Eli Street

Requested change in Zoning from R-8 to R-22 MF (CD), for the development of 8 multifamily rental units.

This Community Meeting Report is being filed with the Office of the City Clerk & the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Commission pursuant to Section 6.203 of the Charlotte Zoning Ordinance.

PERSONS AND ORGANIZATIONS CONTACTED WITH DATES

The required Community Meeting was held on February 19, 2015 at 6:00pm. A representative of the petitioner mailed a notice of the date, time, and location of the Community Meeting to the individuals and organizations set out on **Exhibit A** on February 9, 2015. A copy of the written notice is attached as **Exhibit B**.

TIME & LOCATION OF MEETING

The Community Meeting required by the Ordinance was held on February 19, 2015 at 6:00pm, at Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, 517 Baldwin Avenue, Charlotte, NC 28204.

MEETING SUMMARY – PETITION No. 2015-030 - SITE D

Overview of Petitioner's presentation:

This rezoning is one of five rezoning requests the petitioner is requesting for the Tall Oaks Redevelopment in the Cherry Community. There was an overall presentation of the entire development plan, then each site was presented in more detail (see **Exhibit D** for presentation boards and **Exhibit E** for the handouts provided at the meeting) with a question & answer and feedback session for each rezoning request, and a review session at the end for additional questions/comments for all sites.

Introduction

Sylvia Bittle-Patton opened the Meeting
Invocation by Doris Dennis

A. Fulton Meachem Jr. - CEO & President of Charlotte Housing Authority
Mr. Meachem welcomed the Cherry community members attending and introduced himself and the project representatives.

Mr. Meachem began the presentation to discuss the CHA Tall Oaks Redevelopment and each site:

The CHA has been here before to get your input, and with the community's input, the project team has been able to get better product. The development is targeting the working income groups.

Mr. Meachem made reference to a recent newspaper article regarding the project and stated:

What you saw in paper was only an excerpt of the project that does not represent all the changes that have been worked out recently. So we are going to talk through all that with you tonight and explain what is going on. The CHA wants to make sure that the residents in the current 50 public housing units have an opportunity to come back and through this process we are making sure that happens. But the development replacing the current units will not be public housing at all. One of the key differences between what we have right now and what we are going to be building is a work requirement. But we will be wrapping around supportive services to ensure they have the ability move back and actually go to work, and we will provide brand new housing. Daniel McNamee of the design team will go through the design in more detail. I will now turn it over to Daniel to go through each of those petitions separately so you can ask questions regarding each.

Daniel McNamee then provided an overview of each Rezoning site. He presented a map of the scattered sites in the Neighborhood, Site A, Petition no. 2015-027, on Cherry Street and E. 1st St., by the Metropolitan, and the scattered sites (Sites B-F) in the neighborhood. Site B is Petition no. 2015-028; Site C is Petition no. 2015-029; Site D is Petition no. 2015-030; and Site F is Petition no. 2015-032. For each of the sites, Daniel showed updates of the design, comparing with the drawings presented with those presented at the previous Petitioner's public meeting, held on January 27, 2015.

Overview of Petition # 2015-030 – Site D

Daniel McNamee presented the development plan for Site D. The previous design included a 2 unit townhouse building at the corner of the new Morgan Park Drive, and a 6 unit townhouse building along Luther. The previous input from the neighborhood said that the 6 unit townhome was too long for the neighborhood context and that the parking ratio was too low. The new design now only has 4 townhomes in the one building facing Luther Street, and a quad that's oriented towards Morgan Park Drive. The parking was also increased from 8 parking spaces to 13 parking spaces.

Questions & Comments for Petition # 2015-030 – Site D

Q - Is there an income restriction?

A - \$38,000 and below. There is also a mandatory work requirement. 100% case management.

Q - So this is at the corner of Eli?

A – No, this is at the new Morgan Park Drive, Eli is down the street.

Q - Is there an income limit on this housing?

A – Yes, this would be for those making below \$38,000 and there's a work requirement.

Q - It's true that the big building on Site A is the workforce, yes? But the rest is the CHA tax credit homes?

A - Yes correct.

Q - Dan can you recap that piece you did, comparing the old proposal? The old one was connected townhomes?

A - Yes, before we had 2 townhomes at the corner of Morgan Park, and 6 townhomes on Luther, 8 parking spaces. So new design is 4 townhomes on Luther instead of 6, and a 4 unit quad at the corner, with 13 parking spaces. The new design was changed to be more residential in character, we added a dormer and windows.

Q – So, the quad is oriented toward Morgan Park?

A – There is a door facing Luther and another door to Morgan Park, so it's oriented to both streets, but yes it's technically oriented really towards Morgan Park.

Q - So you'll see similar side elevations and materials, window count, etc. from the other sides as well?

A – Yes, similar material elevations and windows, as the side elevations we show.

Q - Luther is getting a lot of new homes, is it capable of handling the traffic?

A – On Luther for this site, it's a one way entrance drive into this site, and you empty out onto Morgan Park Drive and are able to go left or right on it, and they can get back on Luther from Morgan Park, but Morgan Park Drive is not part of our project.

Q – I have a concern of several cars being dumped on Luther and other streets. Concern of the density of all these sites. I don't understand the density increase. Luther is getting 3 new access points all 150 feet apart.

A - We've reduced the number of units from what we originally proposed based on what we've heard. This is what we're proposing.

Q - Based on what Daniel said, it's not going to be that much different than before, we've gone from 20-40 units in the neighborhood. The amount of traffic that the Saussy Burbank homes will cause will be much more than what is being proposed here. Those homes will have 2-3 cars, so them compared to

what these people are doing, this will be nothing compared to what's going to be coming. All the other cut through traffic from the other projects proposed in and around the neighborhood will be much worse than this.

Q - How do we get more parking? What is driving the numbers here?

A - We have to have the mandatory one parking space per unit, 10% accessible. We are going beyond what is required from us. Where we're able to increase the amount of spots we do.

Q - You are exceeding requirements? This is a huge increase in density - enormous. This is completely in contrast to the MMC Area Plan. Completely contrary and disingenuous.

Janelle: we are not hiding the fact that we are adding density. Continue to take feedback.

Comment - I didn't get notified about neighborhood meetings.

Comment - I'm highly embarrassed the comments by my neighbors tonight. You guys are harping on parking parking parking. That is highly unlikely that this plan will cause issues. Subsidized housing will create much less parking problems than the other new developments.

Comment - Things in the MMC area plan have been violated.

Comment – A lot of people in this room have been notified, if you weren't notified then you should ask yourself why.

Meachem – I'm a southern boy, but you need that on street parking to slow people down. And really you want more on street parking to slow traffic down. We all have our preferences, but on street parking will reduce speeds.

Closing Session with General Questions & Comments for Rezoning Sites

Q – The playground on Site B, is that required? We already have a neighborhood park for all the children. Do we need to have 2 parks?

A - Yes it's a requirement for the tax credit submittal.

Q - My biggest concern is the 200 unit on A. it's a monstrosity.

A – This concept we have here is a development that works financially. We can only do so much on A2-F, and we have this A site, which we have a need in Charlotte for affordable workforce housing, we gave it more of a buffer and scaled this site to what we could to provide a housing type and model that's needed in Charlotte. We want to building affordable and workforce housing and that's what we've created over the past few months with input for the city. We are a public body not a developer, we are a part of the community and you can contact us to help make this a better community. Any process will have some give and take and we've come a long way to make this a better program.

Q - Quick question on Site A2—what's going to be there?

A - Townhomes and units similar to the Site B buildings. The townhomes will be similar to the ones on Site D.

Q - I don't like site A at all, I have a disdain for it. Since each is an independent petition, if any aspect of those don't pass how will you proceed with the whole project?

A - We will most likely go through with all sites. For site A, if the numbers for affordable housing do not work for this site, most likely it would be market rate housing.

Q – So, no city money goes to fund the CHA?

A - No city money funds us, we are 100% funded by HUD.

Q – If the rezoning is successful you'd like to apply for funding from Housing Trust Fund from the City?

A - If awarded the tax credits, we can possibly get housing trust fund, we will apply for it.

Comment - You've reduced number of curb cuts on Luther, fear around density and affordability, the market doesn't indicate issues with current CHA, which is usually of lesser quality than what you're presenting today, this housing is a stone's throw from existing housing you have on Avant. I applaud you all for moving forward with this, when you look at urban context which people understand when they buy here, that density is going to continue to grow, people need to understand that density doesn't cause problems, it's the lack of attention to detail, poor design, things like street trees, on street parking and good design make density okay and not a problem. As someone with a lot of risk here in this neighborhood I applaud u for this design.

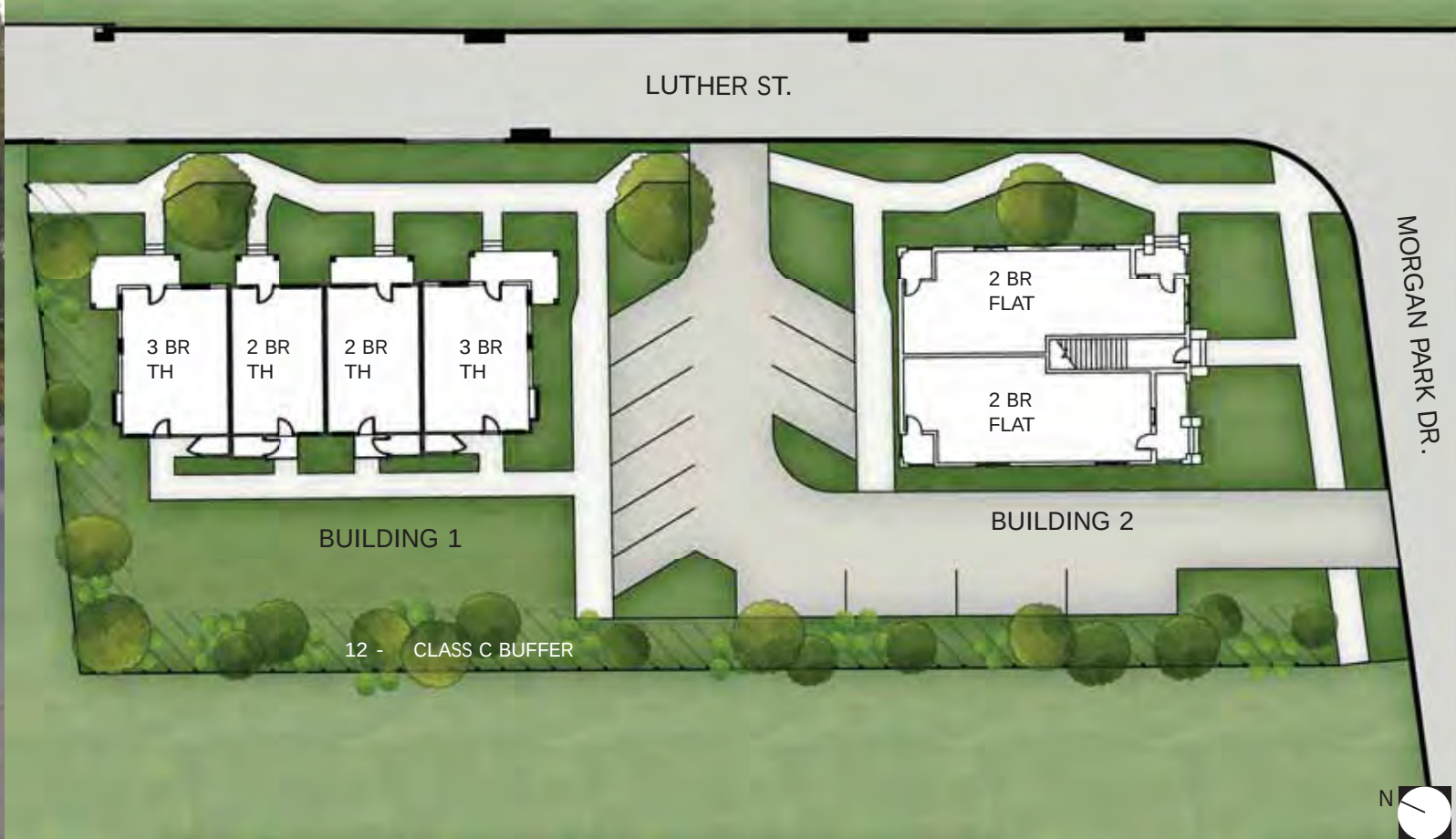

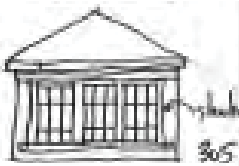

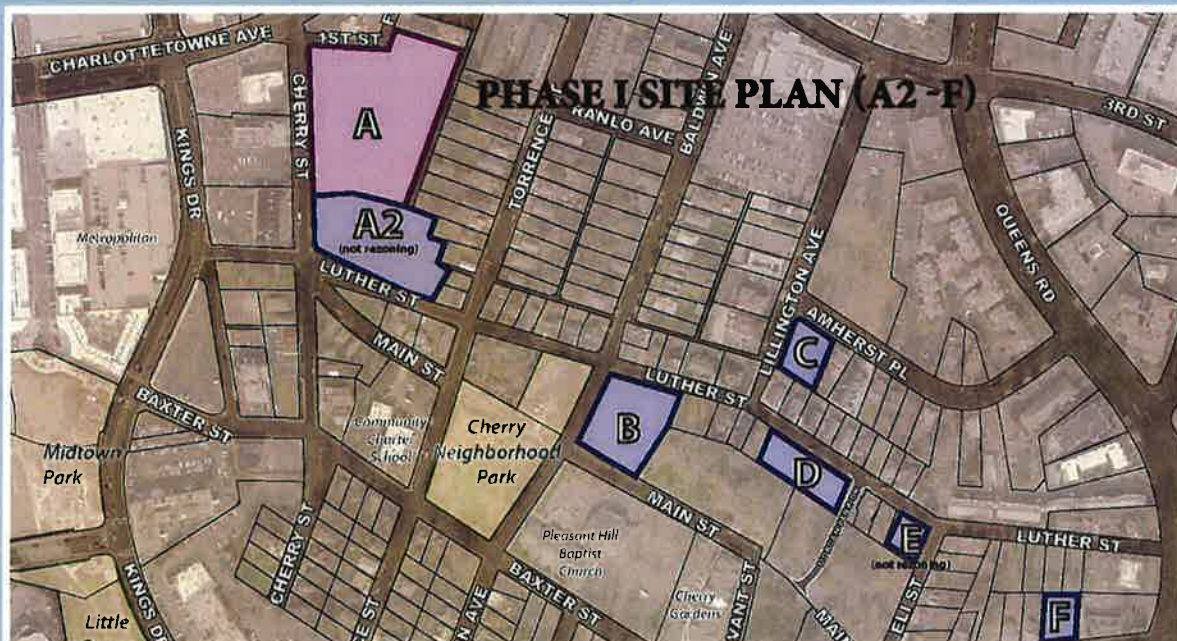
