IMPACT UNDER CURRENT ZONING

Number of housing units allowed under current zoning: The portion of the subject property is developed with three single family detached dwellings, which are legal nonconforming uses. The conventional I-1 zoning district allows all uses permitted in the I-1 district.

IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Proposed Housing Units: The conventional R-8 district request seeks to allow uses permitted in the district, which includes single-family detached dwellings, duplex, triplex and quadraplex units. The approximately 0.41 acres zoned R-8 would allow approximately 3.28 dwellings.

RECOMMENDATION

Adequacy of existing school capacity in this area is a significant problem. We are particularly concerned about rezoning cases where school utilization exceeds 100% since the proposed development may exacerbate those situations. Approval of this petition may increase overcrowding and/or reliance upon mobile classrooms at the school listed above.





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The total estimated capital cost of providing the additional school capacity for this new development is \$20,000 calculated as follows:

Elementary School: 1x \$20,000 = \$20,000

CMS recommends that the petitioner/developer schedule a meeting with staff to discuss mitigation of the cost to improve the adequacy of school capacity at the potentially affected school.
