Concerning Storm Water:

Please label width of all potential stream buffers on rezoning plan, including the Undisturbed Watershed Protection Buffer for the Lake Wylie Protected Area. Depending on project density, the Undisturbed Watershed Buffer can vary from 40' to 100' and should

be labeled as such on the rezoning plan.

Petitioner is advised the 100' SWIM/PCSO Stream Buffers on the site require the inclusion of 50% of the flood fringe area as additional stream buffer. Delineation of the additional stream buffer area may be deferred to the permitting process and is not required

to be shown on the rezoning plan.

Please add the following note under the Environmental Features heading: Development within the SWIM/PCSO/Watershed Buffers shall be coordinated with and subject to approval by Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and mitigated if required by City

ordinance.

Please delete the last sentence of note 6b under the Environmental

Features heading.
