

COMMUNITY	6 COMMUNITIES REGULATE THE HOURS OF NIGHTCLUBS, BARS OR LOUNGES
Atlanta, GA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Neighborhood Commercial: Not open between 2 am and 6:30 am, varies by days of week.
Cincinnati, OH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Within 100' of Residential: Operate only 7 am to midnight on Friday and Saturday and 7 am to 10 pm on other days of the week unless a conditional use permit is approved.
Columbia, SC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hours approved by the Zoning Board of Adjustment if adjacent to Residential.
Greenville, SC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set by the State: Sell 10 am to 2 am the following day. Special exceptions on Saturday and Sunday. Saturday only until midnight and no sales on Sundays.
Miami/Dade County, FL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cabaret: alcohol sales limited to 8 am to 3 am the following day. No sales on Sunday except from 5 pm to 3 am the next day. • Bars, Cocktail lounge alcohol sales limited to 8 am to 1 am the next day. On Sundays, no alcohol sales except from 5 pm to 1 am the next day, and no beer sales except from 10 am to 1 am the next day. • Nightclubs: Sales between 8 am to 4:50 am the next day on weekdays. Beer sales on Sundays from 10 am to 4:50 am the next day. Alcohol sales on Sundays from 5 pm to 4:50 am the next day. If alcohol sold with food at tables on Sunday, can sell 1 pm to 4:50 am the next day. • Nightclubs in unincorporated areas: Close doors no later than 5 am each day.
Phoenix, AZ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hours are regulated in the different form-based “character districts”.
